TSA's Summer Travel Checklist



- Liquids, gels and aerosols as carry-ons must be in:
- 3-ounce or smaller containers placed in a
- **1**-quart, clear, plastic, zip-top bag
- **1** bag per passenger placed in a plastic bin for screening. Larger quantities must be placed in checked luggage.



Double check the contents of your pockets and carry-on baggage to ensure no prohibited items such as knives or firearms were inadvertently packed.

Place firearms and ammunition in your checked baggage and declare them to your airline. Firearms must be unloaded and placed in a locked, hard-sided container.

All fireworks contain explosive materials and are not permitted in checked or carry-on baggage.



You are required to remove footwear for X-ray screening. Wearing footwear that can be easily removed helps speed you through the screening process.



Do not pack fragile or valuable items in checked baggage. Ship or take them with you in carry-on baggage.

Put undeveloped film in carry-on baggage. Checked baggage screening equipment may damage film.
