Are lids removed and containers rinsed?				
Does the unit provide an area to hold large recyclable items and are recyclables being delivered to the proper recycling location in a timely manner?

Does the unit reuse packaging materials?				
Does the unit reuse items when possible, rather than throw them away ?				
Are units using both sides of paper or scrap paper rather than new paper?				
Does the unit have an exchange program in place?				
Have units set up a storage/exchange area for reusable office supplies such as envelopes, file folders, binders, shipping boxes, and packing material?

Are eco-friendly/recycled products being purchased and used by unit?		
Are products like paper being bought in bulk?		
Are less used items being purchased only as needed?		
Is duplex mode set as the default on computers and printers?		
Are units using computers to find and read articles rather than purchase hard copies?		
Do units use reusable cups rather than disposable cups?
