Advocacy: the voice of small business in government

U.S. Territories

Small businesses in the U.S. territories provide economic opportunities to diverse groups of people and bring innovative products and services to the marketplace. This profile from the Office of Advocacy compiles the latest facts and figures on the status and role of small business. (Because of limited firm size information, the number of business establishments is used as a proxy to represent the number of small businesses. In the U.S. in 2006, firms with fewer than 500 employees operated 85 percent of all establishments.)

- Puerto Rico has the largest economy of the U.S. territories. Puerto Rico had more private sector establishments and employment than 14 states in 2007.
- The economy of Guam fared better from 2007 to 2008 than those of Puerto Rico and the Virgin Islands, as employment rose in Guam.
- Please note that total amounts tend to be small in the territories, hence small changes in level from one year to the next may generate very large percentage changes.
