- The Congress did not adopt a FY 2011 budget resolution conference report. However, on July 1, 2010, the House agreed to H. Res. 1493, which provided for a 2011 allocation for the House Committee on Appropriations. The Committee then published 302(b) allocations on July 23, 2010. Subsequently, on January 5, 2011, the House agreed to H. Res. 5, which provided for a new allocation for the Committee. The Committee published the current 302(b) allocations on February 14, 2011.
- In accordance with section 3(c)(2) of H. Res. 5 (112th Congress) and section 423(b) of S. Con. Res. 13 (111th Congress), amounts designated as contingency operations (H. Res. 5) or emergency requirement (S. Con. Res. 13) shall not count for purposes of Sec. 302(b) of the Congressional Budget Act. Therefore, they are excluded from this calculation.
