












Kansas City Area Vacancies (September, 2010)




- <u>10,894</u> KCMO residential structures identified as vacant in Sep. 2010 using USPS data (estimate)
 - 10.4 percent vacancy rate
- KCMO water records show <u>12,077</u> vacancies in Sep. 2010
 - 8.4 percent vacancy rate
- The vacancy rate for single family dwellings in the U.S. as a whole was 3.8 percent (estimate) for single family structures




Percentage Change In Kansas City Area Vacancies (2007 – 2010)




Topeka Area Vacancies (September, 2010)

Wichita Area Vacancies (September, 2010)




Percentage Change In Wichita Area Vacancies (2007 – 2010)

Wider Costs of Vacant Properties


To the community

To cities


- Lost tax revenues

Existing Home Sales


