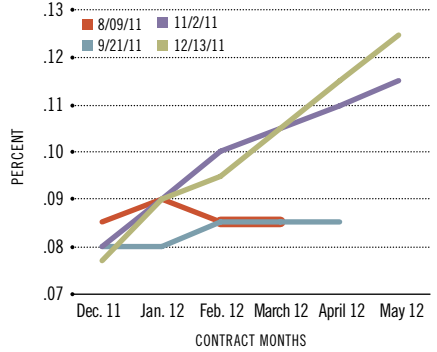

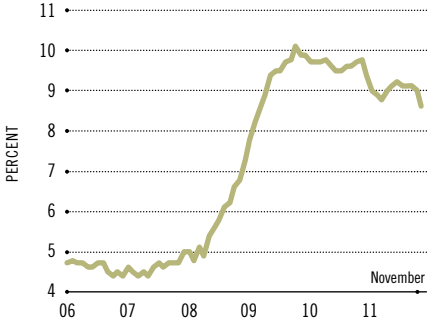
INFLATION-INDEXED TREASURY YIELD SPREADS



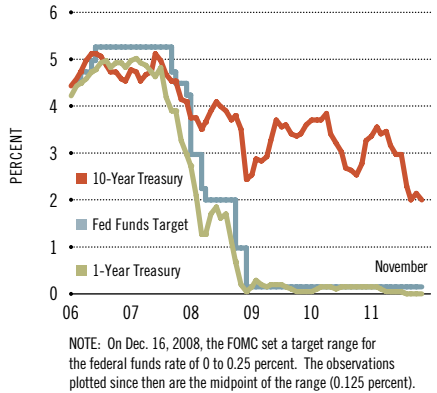

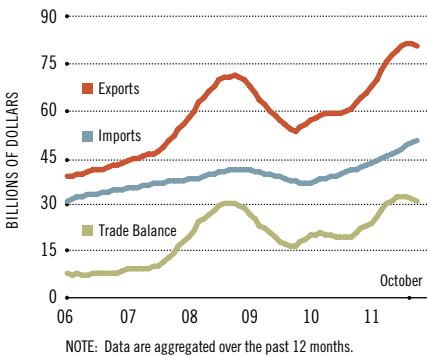

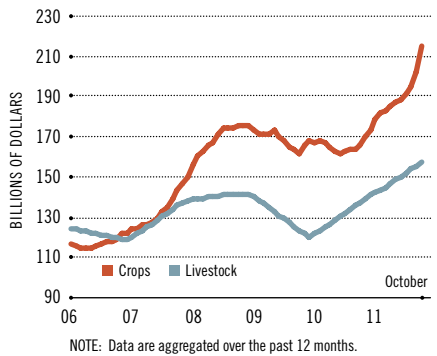

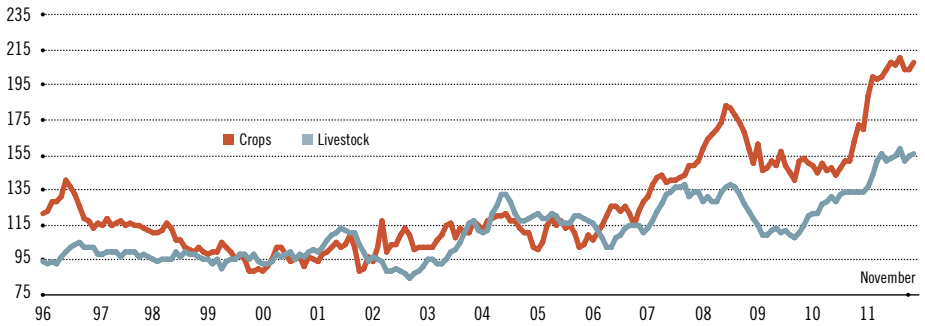

U.S. CROP AND LIVESTOCK PRICES / INDEX 1990-92=100

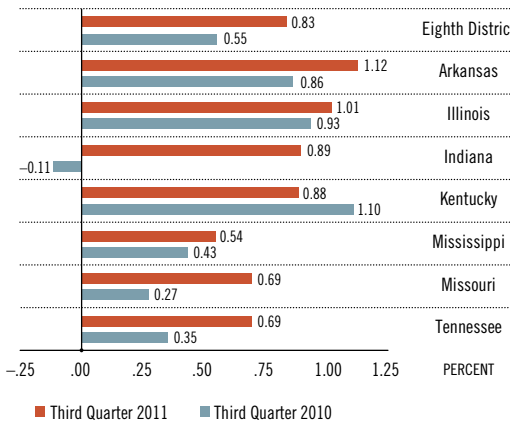

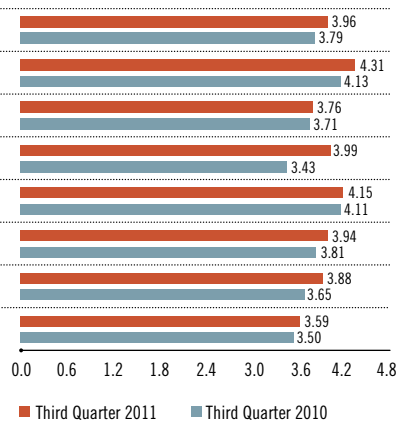

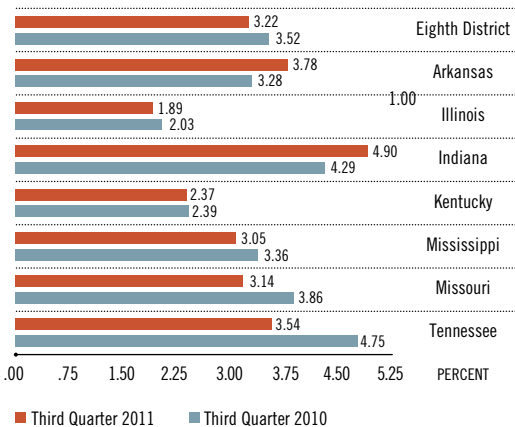
RETURN ON AVERAGE ASSETS*



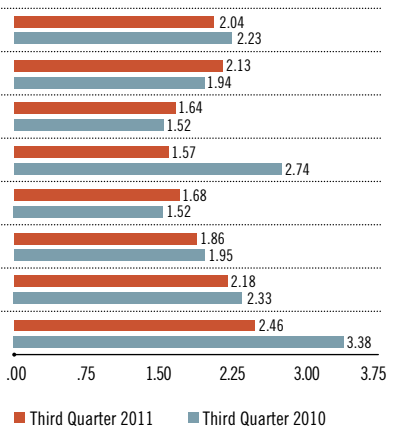
NET INTEREST MARGIN*

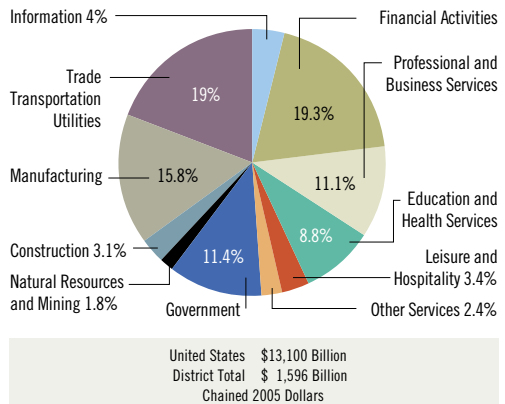

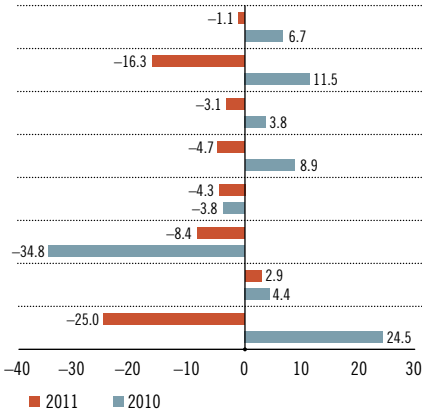

HOUSING PERMITS / THIRD QUARTER

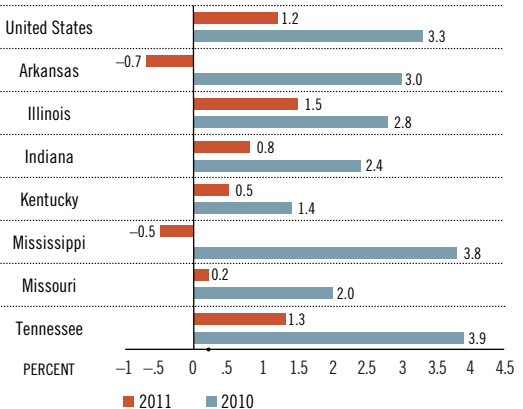
YEAR-OVER-YEAR PERCENT CHANGE IN YEAR-TO-DATE LEVELS
