- **Challenges:**

- Lack of biometrics equities in current Strategic Guidance Documents (i.e., NSS, NMS, NDS).
- 2001 QDR identified biometrics as an emerging technology worthy of vigorous development and exploitation...but the 2006 QDR had **no** reference to biometrics or identity management – a missed opportunity.

- **Desired Outputs:**

- Determine the appropriate entry points for collaborating and influencing strategic guidance documents to ensure inclusion of biometrics equities.
- Identify stakeholders in the biometrics community who will “sign.up” to collaborate and represent the equities of the DoD Biometrics community in the development of various strategic documents.
