Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **DET 12 AMS/DO (Maxwell AFB, AL)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **ANY**. **Must provide a cross training statement stating you will cross train into the 81T0 career field within one year if selected. Must submit official full length military photo.** Duties and Responsibilities: Directly responsible for the management and instruction of four or five six-week Air National Guard Officer Training School classes. A total of 24-30 weeks of actual course execution and 18 weeks of pre-planning are required during the training year. Responsible for helping to formulate training policies, coordinating, monitoring, and executing all education and training activities for Air National Guard Officer Training School officer candidates. The purpose of this position is to manage, coordinate, execute, and monitor all educational activities of the Academy of Military Science (AMS) flight commanders and officer candidates. Responsible for effective implementation of AMS education and training activities. Supervises seven company grade officers and up to 142 students. Counsels students on a broad range of topics including academic or military deficiencies, personal problems, progress in AMS, and human relations. Evaluates and relates student potential to serve effectively as a commissioned officer. Critiques oral and written exercises and drill performance. Provides written summary and recommendations of all counseling. Facilitates group discussions and problem solving activities. Responsible for ensuring that subordinates are properly trained and equipped for mission success. Responsible for evaluation of program effectiveness. Should not have a fear of heights.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Officers applying for a statutory tour position must have a minimum of a Bachelor's degree prior to applying.
