Headquarters ANG Title 10 2-4 years Statutory Tour at **NGB/A1 (TFSC – Denver, CO)**. Must be Air Force Specialty Code (AFSC) **3S031/51/71**. Duties and Responsibilities: Applicants should possess a general knowledge of Air National Guard personnel related programs, a familiarity with personnel operations, and ability to quickly grasp new information. Incumbent requires the ability to comprehend, implement, explain and make decisions in accordance with established procedures and practices. Excellent data entry skills required to quickly process a large amount of issues and information. Proficient computer skills and excellent oral and written communication skills necessary. The ability to work independently; organize, compile and record information accurately; and establish and maintain effective working relationships with co-workers and customers is essential. Applicants should be able to analyze personnel related problems and present proposed solutions. Incumbent requires an understanding of the relationship and structure of the TFSC-Denver full time support personnel force. The ability to learn new processes and/or procedures in minimal time is highly desired. Rotational assignments within the ANG are normal during this tour.

Mandatory criteria as indicated in the MVA must be documented on the members report on individual personnel (RIP). If it is not indicated on the RIP, it is incumbent upon the applicant to ensure that the appropriate source documentation is provided with the application.

Must meet the above stated grade/rank requirement by closeout date of advertisement.

Member must have a Secret Clearance or an open investigation to apply for statutory tour positions.

Any MVA to an overseas location will require additional screening for the selectee and family prior to orders publication.

Enlisted applicants who are higher grade than the highest grade for the advertisement must provide a statement of understanding with the application stating he/she is willing to be voluntarily demoted if selected for this position, IAW ANGI 36-2503, Paragraph 3.8.
