Represents 1AF in the Joint Capabilities Integration and Development System (JCIDS) process. Monitors and reports on issues going to the Air Force Requirements Oversight Council (AFROC) and the Joint Requirements Oversight Council (JROC). Coordinates and/or authors Analysis of Alternatives (AoA) studies and Capabilities Based Assessments (CBAs) as directed by COCOM or COMAFFOR. Prepares, submits and advocates to NORAD/USNORTHCOM for air component requirements supporting the COCOMs Integrated Priority List (IPL) development. Investigates and participates in Joint Capabilities Technology Demonstrations (JCTDs) and Joint Test Evaluations (JTEs) to investigate and advocate for new and emerging capabilities supporting the Homeland Defense mission. Integrates AFFOR execution requirements efforts with Joint Task Forces, multinational, and Service staffs throughout the campaign planning and execution processes. Determines requirements for additional USAF forces or capabilities. Oversees development and

implementation of policies and procedures which task the operational readiness and effectiveness of the 1AF and its subordinate units. Executes annual 1AF Strategic Requirements processes to specify theater-level command goals. Integrates requirements throughout the staff and subordinate units. Ensures alignment of requirements with higher headquarters requirements directorates via the Defense Readiness Reporting System (DRRS). Prepares staff correspondence, briefings and complex technical reports for use by 1AF and higher headquarters senior staffs to include Department of Defense, Combatant Commanders, MAJCOM staffs and Air Staff. When directed, supplements AFNORTH/CONR Operations staff or the Air Operations Center to handle emerging operational crises real-time. When directed, serves as a Joint Air Component Coordination Element (JACCE) Director in support of disaster and/or contingency response operations. Assists the A3 and Commander in tracking AF Advanced Programs and STO programs which have equity in the CONR-1AF mission
