

About Defense Security Service

CONTRIBUTING TO NATIONAL SECURITY

The Defense Security Service (DSS) is an agency of the Department of Defense (DoD) located in Quantico, VA, with field offices throughout the United States. The Under Secretary of Defense for Intelligence provides authority, direction, and control over DSS. DSS provides the military services, Defense Agencies, 23 Federal agencies, and approximately 12,000 cleared contractor facilities with security support services.

DSS Vision and Mission

DSS is the premier provider of personnel and industrial security services in the DoD. DSS supports and improves national security and the warfighter, secures the Nation's technological base, and oversees the protection of U.S. and foreign classified information in the hands of industry.

We accomplish this mission by clearing industrial facilities, personnel, and associated information systems; collecting, analyzing, and providing threat information to industry and Government partners; managing foreign ownership control and influence in cleared industry; providing advice and oversight to industry; delivering security education and training; and providing information technology services that support the industrial security mission of DoD and its partner agencies.

CORE MISSION AREAS

National Industrial Security Program

DSS administers and implements the defense portion of the National Industrial Security Program pursuant to Executive Order 12829. Approximately 285 Industrial Security Representatives are spread across the United States in four geographic regions. They provide oversight and assistance to cleared contractor facilities and assist the organization's management and Facility Security Officers in ensuring protection of national security information. DSS has responsibility for approximately 12,000 cleared contractor facilities. DISCO, located in Columbus, Ohio, processes requests for industrial personnel security investigations and provides eligibility or clearance determinations for cleared industry personnel under the NISP.

CDSE

The Center for Development of Security Education (CDSE) directorate is located in Linthicum, MD, and oversees the missions of Education, Training, Security Professionalization, Technology-Enhanced Learning, and Security Analysis and Innovation. CDSE provides security education and training to DoD and other U.S. Government personnel and employees of foreign governments. Its professional staff of instructors, technology professionals, and education support personnel combine expertise to create, collaborate, and facilitate delivery of quality education and training. Through formal classroom, computer-based training, and distance learning, the CDSE provides a curriculum focusing on the core security disciplines, Physical, Information, Industrial, Personnel, and Special Access Programs while integrating Counterintelligence and Information Systems Security.

SCDPO Services

The Security Career Development and Professionalization Office (SCDPO) facilitates development validation and maintenance of security skill standards and identifies security education and training products that address those standards. In addition, SCDPO provides career development advice and guidance to assist security professionals and practitioners with identifying appropriate security education and training resources available that will enhance their proficiency. SCDPO supports existing and emerging DoD strategic initiatives to broaden the knowledge of professionalism within the security community.

About the Security Professional Education Development (SPēD) Program

What is the SPeD Certification Program?

The SPēD Certification Program is the Department of Defense (DoD) initiative to professionalize the security workforce. The SPēD program has three elements: training and education, security professionalization (workshops and outreach), and the SPēD Certification Program, which ensures that security practitioners can demonstrate proficiency in a common set of competencies. The purpose of the SPēD Certification Program is to promote interoperability, facilitate development and training, and develop a workforce of certified security professionals.

How do I schedule a SPeD Certification Assessment?

Before beginning the process, notify your supervisor of your plans to schedule a SPēD Certification Assessment.

Step One: Component must identify you as an applicant or you may volunteer based on your

Component's SPēD Candidate policy.

Step Two: Create of update your STEPP account to be added to the SPeD Certification Audience.

Step Three: Contact your Component SPeD Project Management Office to schedule your test date

and time.

Step Four: Register for the Certification Assessment via SPeDCert.Registration@dss.mil with your

confirmed scheduled test site location, date, and time.

What should I expect at the test site?

The SPēD Certification Assessment is administered via computer in a proctored environment. The Assessment is password-protected and hosted on a secure server to assure privacy and integrity. The test takes approximately three hours.

On the day of the Assessment, be sure to bring your registrar confirmation email, STEPP username and password, and government-issued photo identification (Common Access Card (CAC), or driver's license).

How do I know if I am certified?

The candidate must earn a score that is equivalent to or exceeds the passing score. Candidates will be notified of results by their DoD Component after formal review of their results by their DoD Component and USD(I).

From Baltimore:

- Take I-95 South to 695 East
- Take I-695 East to 295 South (Baltimore-Washington Parkway)
- Take the W. Nursery Road exit
- Turn left on W. Nursery Road
- Turn right at the 3rd traffic light onto Winterson Road
- Please refer to Student Parking Directions on page 2 or the Student Parking Map on page 16
- CDSE is on the left; number 938 is on the upper left front of the building

From Baltimore Washington International (BWI) Thurgood Marshall Airport:

- CDSE is 5 to 10 minutes from BWI Airport
- Follow Elm Road from the airport; turn right on Terminal Road; cross Rt. 170 (Airport Loop)
- Turn left at the light onto Elkridge Landing Road
- Turn left off Elkridge Landing Road before the light at Winterson Road (This left is just past the Springhill Suites by Marriott Hotel on the right.)
- Please refer to Student Parking Directions on page 2 or the Student Parking Map on page 16
- CDSE is the second building on the right; No. 938 is on the upper left front of the building

Student Parking

Please park in the designated area. CDSE shares the parking lots with tenants of other buildings and parking in the inappropriate area can result in your vehicle being towed. Directions to the designated parking area are available at the front desk.

CDSE Student Parking Lot

- From Winterson Road (Baltimore or Washington, D.C., area directions), make a left at the light onto Elkridge Landing Road.
- Make the next right turn and then a quick left turn into the first parking lot on the left. (Student Parking signs are posted at the entrance.)

- or -

- From Elkridge Landing Road (BWI Airport directions), after taking the last left before reaching
 the light on Winterson Road, make a quick left turn into the first parking lot on the left.
 (Student Parking signs are posted at the entrance.)
- To enter the CDSE, exit the CDSE Student Parking entrance to the left and walk to the second building on the right. Number 938 is on the upper left front of the building. Enter through the front door.

Overflow Parking Lot (also for students)

- From Winterson Road, continue past first parking lot entrance.
- Turn left into the Candlewood Suites entrance.
- Follow signs to FANX Overflow Parking and park.
- Walk from the Overflow Lot to the sidewalk heading back to the buildings closest to Winterson Road. CDSE is the first building at the end of this sidewalk; enter through the front door.

- or

 Walk on Winterson Road from the Candlewood Suites entrance to the first building on right; enter through the front door.

Hours of Operation

Classes begin at 0800 daily and end at approximately 1630. Students can enter the building at any time between 0730 and 1630.

Arrival / In-Processing

Please arrive 15 to 30 minutes early to check in at the front desk. Photo identification is required to gain entry to the facility. Please have your government-issued photo I.D. or another form of photo I.D readily available upon your arrival. Once you arrive at the CDSE, please take a look at the map on page 16 to ensure you are parked in the correct location. All parking immediately outside the building is reserved for staff and guest speakers.

Once you enter the building on the first day of class, you will be asked to sign-in at the front desk and will be given a badge and a castle key for the duration of your class. Upon sign-in and badge and castle key reception, the course administrator will instruct you as to where in the building your course will be held.

Dress Code




