### Command changes Wing, operations, mission support, airlift, operations support and state command chief leadership changes

Change has come to various leadership positions in the 166th Airlift Wing and Delaware Air National Guard, starting during the June 2-3 Unit Training Assembly and continuing through the July 14-15 UTA.

On June 2 the wing saw a change of command.

Colonel Michel J. Feeley is the new commander of the 166th Airlift Wing, replacing Col. Jonathan Groff.

On June 3 three changes occurred within the operations group.

Lieutenant Col. James D. Byerly is the new commander of the 166th Operations Group, replacing Col. Feeley.

Lieutenant Col. Robert E. Culcasi is the new commander of the 142nd Airlift Squadron, replacing Col. Byerly.

Lieutenant Col. Craig M. Conrad is the new commander of the 166th Operations Support Flight, filling a vacant position.

The July UTA brings further change. Lieutenant Col. John Ptak is the new commander of the 166th Mission Support Group (and was subsequently promoted to colonel), replacing Col. Don Bevis.

Chief Master Sgt. Steven Stinsky assumed authority as the new Delaware ANG State Command Chief, replacing Chief Master Sgt. Lynn Davis, who previously served as wing command chief.

This social media milestone comes on the heels of the wing page becoming one of the top five most Liked Facebook pages out of all Air National Guard C-130 airlift wings.

Other positive trends show up in Facebook "Insights," metrics that measure visitor interaction with a page. For example, there were 3,770 people reached the week ending May 4, 2012,



breaking the old record of 2,421 people reached the week ending April 17, 2012.

In late June our wing page become the fifth most "Liked" page in the ANG C-130 airlift wing community.
