SUBJECT: Environmental Commitment Statement

 - c) Build environmental concerns into all policies, programs, and missions;
 - d) Integrate environmental information into all of management;
 - e) Set environmental goals, measure progress, and take corrective action when necessary;
 - f) Achieve continuous improvements in environmental performance over and above regulatory and legislative requirements; and
 - g) Work in partnership with all stakeholders to promote waste reduction.
3. Compliance with this Environmental Commitment Statement is the responsibility of every member of the Utah Air National Guard and everyone working on behalf of the Utah Air National Guard, including contractors and visitors.
4. The Utah Air National Guard has achieved an enviable environmental record within the Air National Guard. Through continued emphasis on being good stewards of the environment in which we share with the local community, we prove that we are good neighbors and citizens within the City of Salt Lake, and the state of Utah.
