The CDSE is the one-stop shop for classes and testing offering the Introduction to DoD Personnel Security Adjudication Course which is web-based and can be taken at any time, and the Introduction to DoD Personnel Security Adjudication Course which is instructor-led.

The ACP consists of two tests – the adjudicator practical knowledge test and the adjudicator job knowledge test.

If you perform due process functions, you may also qualify for an additional due process credential. The DP credential consists of two tests - the DP practical knowledge test and the DP job knowledge test. These supplemental tests can be taken on the same day, or taken separately.
