SUBJECT: Wide Area Workflow-Receipt and Acceptance – Resale Contracts

Due to the recent concerns voiced by Industry on whether resale contractors are subject to Wide Area Workflow-Receipt and Acceptance (WAWF-RA) at this time, the following is provided:

- a. Currently, DeCA's Resale Contracting Division utilizes Delivery Ticket Invoicing (DTI) method through the Standard Automated Voucher Examination System, and is an acceptable electronic means for submission of invoices at this time.
- b. The use of Electronic Data Interchange (EDI) transaction sets for resale to include the EDI 875-Grocery Purchase Order, 812-Credit/Debit Adjustment, 867-Product Transfer and Resale, 879-Price Change, 856-Advance Ship Notice, and 824-Application Advice remain unchanged.
