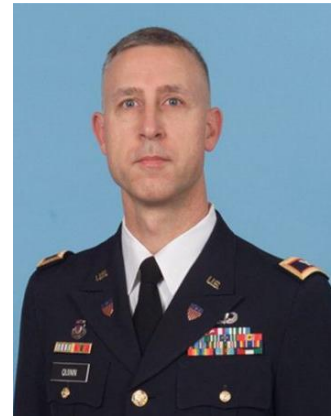


Colonel Thomas G. Quinn, Jr.

Colonel Tom Quinn is a native of Cleveland, GA. He is an ROTC graduate and was commissioned as an officer in the Air Defense Artillery Corps on 8 May 1988.

Colonel Quinn has served in command and staff positions throughout his 24 years of service.
