By the Numbers:

Troops in Theater: 78,080

- Navy: 6,200
- Air Force: 31,000
- Army: 40,000
- Marines: 880

U.S. Bases in Theater: 28 main operating bases.

- Navy: 4
- Air Force: 8
- Army: 16
- Marines: 0

EUCOM Budget: \$127 million for operations, divided up within directorates.

EUCOM Major Exercises:

Combined Endeavour – largest command, control, communication and computer interoperability exercise in the world. Prepares nations to collaborate and execute complex C4 systems in crisis response and combat operations, while building regional and global partnerships.

Juniper Cobra – combined air defense exercise designed to improve interoperability between the United States and Israeli forces.

Jackal Stone – partnership-building exercise coordinated primarily by SOCEUR aimed at providing SOF units multinational training and sharing of mutual doctrine, training concepts, tactics and procedures.

Capable Logistician – logistics standardization and interoperability field training exercise.

Georgia Deployment Program – coordinated with MARFOREUR to train and build partnerships with Georgian military towards Afghanistan operations.

Logistics Exercises – aimed towards improving multinational expeditionary logistics capability and interoperability through bilateral and multinational engagements.

EUCOM Component Commands:

U.S. Naval Forces Europe (NAVEUR) – conducts and supports Naval operations in Europe.

U.S. Army Europe (USAREUR) – trains and supports U.S. Army presence in Europe.

U.S. Air Forces in Europe (USAFE) – major Air Force command and EUCOM's primary air component in the region.

U.S. Marine Forces Europe (MARFOREUR) – acts as the Marine Corps presence in Europe.

U.S. Special Operations Command Europe (SOCEUR) – conducts special operations, humanitarian assistance, non-combatant evacuation, counter-terrorism and other SOF operations in Europe.
