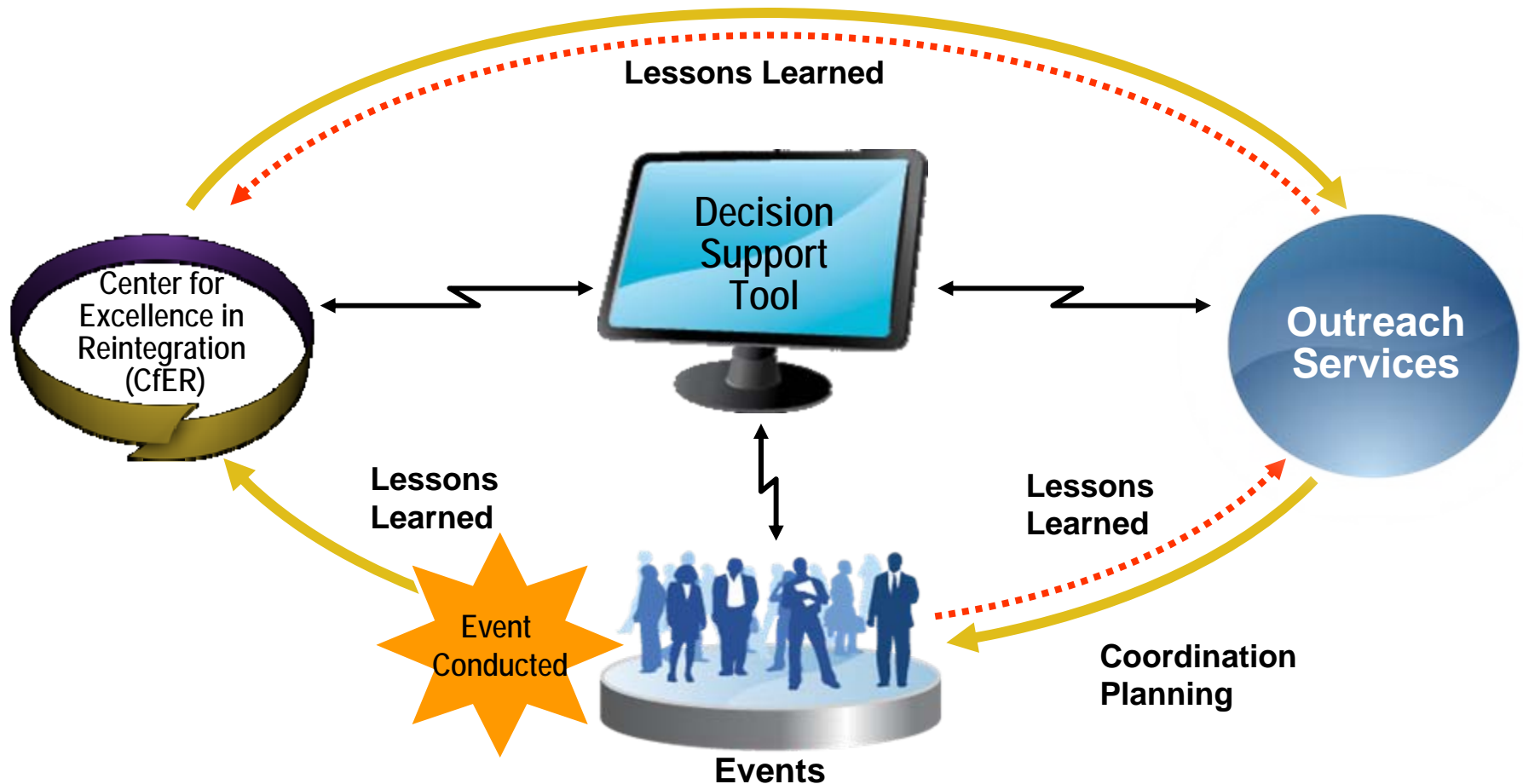
Required by P.L. 110-181 (2008 NDAA):

- ❖ Based on 1/34 BCT experience
- ❖ DoD program to provide informational events/activities to facilitate access to services throughout the entire deployment cycle
 - ❖ Pre-deployment
 - ❖ *From time of alert to deployment; prepare for the rigors of combat*
 - ❖ Deployment
 - ❖ *Focus on challenges and stress associated with separation and combat*
 - ❖ Demobilization
 - ❖ *While at demob station until depart for home station; educate members about available resources and connect members to service providers*
 - ❖ Post-deployment/reconstitution
 - ❖ *From arrival at home station for the next 180 days*
 - ❖ *Reintegration activities required at 30-, 60- and 90-day intervals*
 - ❖ *Focus on reconnecting with family, community, and employer for successful reintegration*



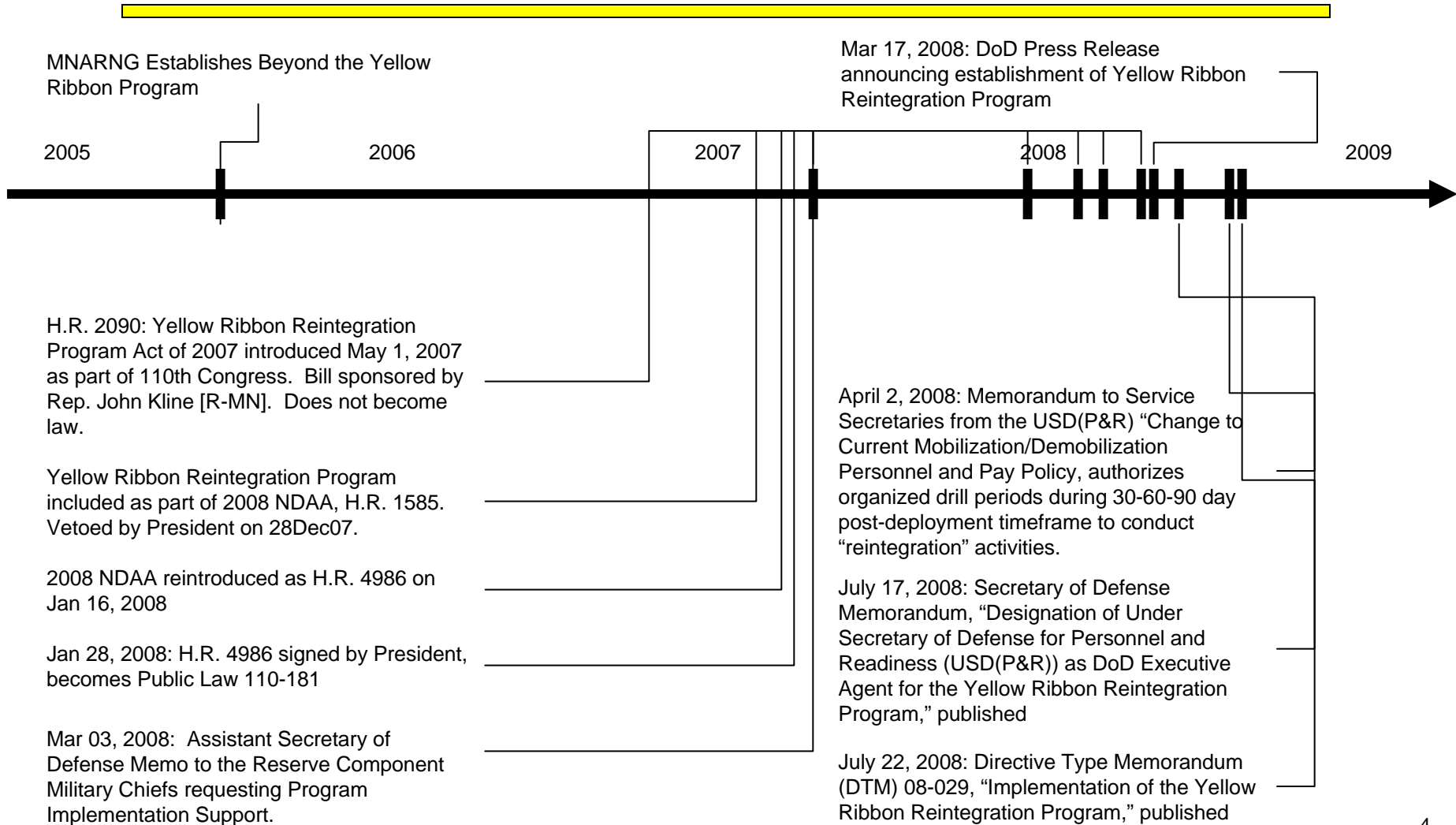

Current Practices

- ❖ USAR has successfully hosted an Event where 3 types of events were held simultaneously (Pre Deployment, During Deployment and a 60 Day) for over 750 Service members and families with outstanding Daycare
- ❖ Navy (Salt Lake City) Returning Warriors Workshop: 40% ARNG, 47% Navy, 13% USMCR Service member attendance
- ❖ National Guard Bureau is hosting an all Service Training on the YRRP Decision Support Tool for Event management and Center for Excellence information
