Boyce E. Bourland Director of Engineering



Boyce E. Bourland is director of engineering for the Defense Commissary Agency, headquartered at Fort Lee, Va., a position he has held since 2004. He is responsible for the planning, programming, design, construction, maintenance and repair of commissary facilities worldwide.

Mr. Bourland's career began at the San Antonio Real Property Maintenance Agency (SARPMA) in 1982, where he completed an engineering intern program, gaining experience in design, project programming, and construction management.

Mr. Bourland began his commissary career in 1985, when he joined the Air Force Commissary Service (AFCOMS) as a project programmer. He later became a project manager and moved to AFCOMS' European Region in Germany where he served as a member of the transition team that helped merge the military's separate commissary systems into one agency in 1991.

Mr. Bourland moved to the Air Force Center for Environmental Excellence (AFCEE) in 1992. While at AFCEE, he managed Air Force MILCON projects and military family housing projects, including privatized housing. He became the Air Force's subject matter expert for accessibility and force protection and sat on the tri-service working group that authored the original antiterrorism and force protection construction standards. He returned to DeCA in 2004 as the facilities program manager.
