

## Waynesville School District

The Waynesville School District offers continuous enrollment for new families moving to the community. Students in grades Kindergarten through twelve, who live within school district boundaries, including housing on Fort Leonard Wood, are encouraged to enroll as soon as possible after arriving. Elementary schools grades are K-5, middle school grades are 6-8, and high school grades are 9-12. Students should enroll in the building assigned for their residence location. New students should bring their last grade card, a transfer sheet, and a shot record, along with other information available from the previous school attended.

The Waynesville School District has several programs to meet the needs of their students. These programs include Parent and Child Education, Special Series Department, Guidance Services, Early Childhood Special Education, Learning Enrichment and Acceleration Program, School Library Media and Instructional Technology Services, Parents as Teachers, Office of Curriculum and Instruction, as well as the A+ Schools Program, for high school students. Missouri Law states that a child is eligible for admission to kindergarten in the Waynesville R-VI schools if the child reaches age five before the first day of August. To enter first grade, the child must reach age six prior to August 1<sup>st</sup>. A registered birth certificate must be presented at the time of enrollment for kindergarten and first grade for new enrollees to the Waynesville School District.

Students who are entering the Waynesville School district for the first time must have a recent physical examination. This must be done prior to enrolling children into their respective schools. A duly licensed medical practitioner must have completed all physical examinations within the last twelve months. Physical request forms and specific information regarding the required immunizations may be obtained at the Waynesville School District Personnel Office, Administration Building, 200 Fleetwood Drive, Waynesville, MO 65583. All seventh grade students must have Hepatitis B immunizations.
