DLA Disposition Services Transition to Reutilization Business Integration (RBI)

RBI Deployment Update

As discussed in our last update, DLA Disposition Services is updating its computer system. We are transitioning from the legacy DRMS Automated Information System (DAISY) to the Reutilization Business Integration (RBI) solution. This significant shift will occur over the next 8 months.

One of the major changes for customers is the activation of the DLA Enterprise External Web Portal on March 26, 2012. Access to Electronic Turn-in Documents (ETID), Reutilization/Transfer/Donation (RTD), and some reporting applications is through this single sign-on portal. Below are key points about the portal and actions to take during its launch. Also included is information about the new Transportation Scheduler.

External Web Portal: Gaining Access to ETID/RTD applications

DLA Account Management and Provisioning System (AMPS) is a web-based account management system that allows users to request, create, and manage DLA accounts.

Customers will need to create an account via AMPS to conduct business using ETID, RTD, and generate certain reports.

After creating your AMPS account, you will need to submit a role request that specifies the ETID, RTD application, or reports you need access to. You will receive an email verifying that your request for access has been approved.

Successful registration through AMPS allows the user to access the ETID, RTD and reports applications through the external web portal.

DCO Connect directions: Access the link <https://connect.dco.dod.mil/rbitraining>. Log in as a guest. Identify your first and last name when prompted. Make sure your computer speakers are turned on so you can hear the presentation.

- Job aids will guide AMPS users to create accounts in AMPS.

Transportation Scheduler

The new Scheduler is expected to go live March 26, 2012

Benefits to the Customer

- Updated appearance
- Greater functionality
- Local schedule calendar visibility
- Automatic appointment confirmation emails

Customer Interface

Once the customer logs into the Scheduler, the first page displayed will show the next available date to bring property in for disposition.

- If that date doesn't work, then the user can click a link, and the following calendar will appear.



- The days with open appointments will appear white.
- The link at the top of the calendar will allow you to go to the next month for scheduling if preferred.
- Customers will be able to pick a date/time slot and request it for turn-in. The system will then block that date and time for the customer, safeguarding against duplicate appointments.

ETIDS

- The customer will still submit their ETIDs for approval before going in to schedule an appointment. ETIDs must be approved before scheduling an appointment.
- The new Scheduler will allow the customer to select approved ETIDs to attach to their appointment.

New Transaction Processing

Benefits to the Customer

- Receipt acknowledgement to Inventory Control Point
- Receipt of Supply Discrepancy Reports (notification of rejected property)
- Navy/Army/Marine Corps customer will receive advance shipment notification of ordered property
- Army/Air Force/Marine Corps notification of excess property from customer

Background

- RBI replaces the existing DAISY processes with Defense Logistics Management System (DLMS) transactions to support shipping, receipt and property management

Risks to the Army/Navy/Marine Corps

- Army/Navy/Marine Corps will need to revise their current interfaces to accept/interface with the new DLMS transactions in order to receive advance shipment notifications, receipts, and notification of rejected property. Discussions are ongoing.
