Key Accomplishments:

- ✓ Full implementation of the SFLC, including realignment of ELC/MLC/ NESU personnel into five Product Lines and five Shared Services Divisions.
- Creation of the first-ever centralized, nationwide oversight of Coast Guard Industrial capabilities highlighted by incorporation of the Industrial Service Activities into NESUs.
