 15 Mar 78 - Judy Miller of SpecAsst to SecDef Off called LAC for info to respond to the HSCA's ltr to the White House requesting info which they asked from NSA back in Dec 77. She said SecDef had directed that office (in lieu of OSI) to respond to responses from that Committee. She also said the Sec was going to reply in the negative.

24 Mar - Rcvd (via LDX) cy of Spec Assistant (Kester) memo to D/SecDef proposing course of action.


