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## 1 SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.

2 This Act may be cited as the "Ensuring Pay for Our3 Military Act of 2011".

4 SEC. 2. EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION OF FUNDS TO PRO5 VIDE PAY AND ALLOWANCES FOR MEMBERS
6 OF THE ARMED FORCES DURING FUNDING
7 GAP IMPACTING THE DEPARTMENT OF DE8 FENSE OR DEPARTMENT OF HOMELAND SE9 CURITY.

10 (a) Appropriation of Funds for Military Pay 11 AND ALLOWANCES.—During a funding gap impacting the Armed Forces, the Secretary of the Treasury shall make 12 13 available to the Secretary of Defense (and the Secretary of Homeland Security in the case of the Coast Guard), 14 out of any amounts in the general fund of the Treasury 15 16 not otherwise appropriated, such amounts as the Secretary of Defense (and the Secretary of Homeland Security in 17 the case of the Coast Guard) determines to be necessary 18 to continue to provide pay and allowances (without inter-19 ruption) to members of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Ma-20 rine Corps, and Coast Guard, including reserve compo-21 22 nents thereof, who perform active service during the fund-23 ing gap.

(b) FUNDING GAP DEFINED.—In this section, the
term "funding gap" means any period of time after the
beginning of a fiscal year for which interim or full-year

appropriations for the personnel accounts of the Armed
 Forces for that fiscal year have not been enacted.

3 (c) DURATION OF TRANSFER AUTHORITY.—No
4 transfer may be made by the Secretary of the Treasury
5 under subsection (a) after December 31, 2011.
