Reference is made to a Principal Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense (Health Affairs) memorandum dated 15 August 1995, subject Information Support for Revised Financing in TRICARE Regions 1, 2 and 5. In response to this memorandum the Services provided detailed Ambulatory Data System (ADS) deployment schedules.
