SUBJECT: Access to Primary Care Managers at Military Treatment Facilities

- (c) ASD (HA) 98-032 Policy Memorandum: Improving Consumer Choice of Primary Care Manager in the Military Health System

This policy, in conjunction with reference (a), supersedes reference (b), which is hereby cancelled. This policy specifies 24-hour access to primary care managers (PCMs).

In Accordance with reference (c) beneficiaries have the right to choose a Primary Care Manager (PCM). Once a beneficiary chooses and has been assigned a PCM, Military Treatment Facility (MTF) commanders must ensure that availability of MTF PCMs to the MTF's TRICARE Prime enrollees satisfies the same access standard as required of managed care support contractors. All TRICARE Prime beneficiaries shall have access to their PCM or a designated PCM representative by telephone, 24 hours a day, seven days a week. A PCM may be an MTF, clinic, practice site or an individual provider.
