SUBJECT: Policy for Service AHLTA End User Device Standard Configuration(s)

The Military Health System (MHS), working with the Services, maintains a set of minimum hardware and software requirements for AHLTA end user devices (EUDs) in use at military treatment facilities (MTFs). However, in the absence of a set of standard configurations, the variety of EUD hardware and software configurations has proliferated within and across the Services to the point that AHLTA maintenance is impacted.

With the worldwide implementation and management of AHLTA, the MHS needs to reduce workstation variability to improve application management and troubleshooting, facilitate the ordering process, minimize hardware and software conflicts, and optimize performance. Towards that end, each Service is to determine its AHLTA EUD requirements and provide a written policy detailing a single standard hardware and software configuration for AHLTA EUDs within 90 days of the date of this memorandum.
