RMKS/1. REF A THROUGH D DIRECTED ANTHRAX VACCINE IMMUNIZATIONS BASED ON THREAT ANALYSIS AND AVAILABILITY OF A SAFE, FOOD AND DRUG ADMINISTRATION (FDA) APPROVED ANTHRAX VACCINE. SINCE 1998, DOD HAS SAFELY VACCINATED OVER 1 MILLION MILITARY, EMERGENCY-ESSENTIAL CIVILIAN, AND MISSION-ESSENTIAL CONTRACTOR PERSONNEL TO PROVIDE VITAL PROTECTION AGAINST ALL FORMS OF ANTHRAX DISEASE.

- 2. ON 27 OCTOBER 2004, THE UNITED STATES DISTRICT COURT FOR THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA ISSUED A NEW INJUNCTION AGAINST THE DOD AVIP. PER REF E, EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY, DOD WILL STOP ADMINISTERING ANTHRAX IMMUNIZATIONS UNTIL FURTHER NOTICE.
- 3. THE NEW INJUNCTION IS SIMILAR TO THE ONE ISSUED IN REF G, AT WHICH TIME, DOD PAUSED AVIP PENDING CLARIFICATION OF LEGAL ISSUES.
 THE DECEMBER INJUNCTION WAS LIFTED APPROXIMATELY 2 WEEKS LATER PER REF H. PER REF E, THE NEW INJUNCTION AGAIN REQUIRES FDA TO COMPLETE REQUIRED PROCEDURES BEFORE ISSUING A FINAL RULE THAT THE ANTHRAX VACCINE IS SAFE AND EFFECTIVE FOR PROTECTION AGAINST INHALATION ANTHRAX.
- 4. ADDITIONAL ACTIONS:
- A. PER REF F, SVP WILL CONTINUE AND IS NOT IMPACTED BY THE INJUNCTION NOR THIS NAVADMIN.
- B. PER REF D PARA 3, CONTINUE TO SCREEN ALL ACTIVE AND RESERVE MEDICAL RECORDS FOR COMPLIANCE WITH ALL IMMUNIZATIONS, ENSURING IMMUNIZATION DATA IS CAPTURED IN THE MEDICAL RECORD, ON THE PHS-731 (YELLOW SHOT CARD) AND INTO AN APPROVED ELECTRONIC DATA SYSTEM THAT TRANSMITS TO DEERS.
- C. FOR ANY PENDING MILITARY JUSTICE ISSUES, CONSULT WITH A STAFF JUDGE ADVOCATE IN YOUR CHAIN OF COMMAND.
- D. UNOPENED VIALS OF ANTHRAX VACCINE WILL BE STORED IN PLACE UNTIL FURTHER INSTRUCTIONS ARE ISSUED.
- E. ALL ACTIVITIES WILL CONSOLIDATE AND REPORT THE INVENTORY OF ALL UNOPENED VIALS OF ANTHRAX VACCINE BY LOT NUMBER TO NAVMEDLOGCOM.
