HOMC HAS REVISED THE AVIP AND SVP REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS IN ORDER TO MIRROR THE MONTHLY REPORTING REQUIREMENT SOLICITED BY THE OFFICE OF THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE. THIS MARADMIN DISSEMINATES REVISED AVIP/SVP REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS AND PROVIDES SUPPORTING ESTABLISHMENT (SE) COMMANDS WITH SPECIFIC GUIDANCE IN SUBMITTING REQUIRED DATA. 2. CMC INTENT. PREVIOUS CMC POLICY AND PROCEDURES GOVERNING THE AVIP/SVP REMAIN IN EFFECT. HOWEVER, THE CONTENT AND REPORTING FORMAT HEREIN SUPERECEDE THAT FOUND IN REFS A, B, AND C. ADDITIONALLY, WHILE THE ADMINISTERING OF INNOCULATIONS TO PERSONNEL WITHIN THE AVIP HAS BEEN PAUSED (PER REF D), THE REQUIREMENT TO REPORT THE FOLLOWING DATA REMAINS. 3. EXECUTION A. REPORTING. UPON ADMINISTERING THE ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX VACCINES TO SERVICE MEMBERS, COMMANDERS ARE DIRECTED TO ENSURE COMPLIANCE WITH SERVICE REPORTING INSTRUCTIONS VIA NAVAL MESSAGE. ALL MARFORS, LOGCOM, AND SE COMMANDS (IDENTIFIED BELOW IN PARA 3.B.(2)) WILL REPORT IMMUNIZATION DATA, ADDRESSED TO CMC WASHINGTON DC (POR) WITH INFO COPY TO CMC WASHINGTON DC (PLN AND HS), BY THE SEVENTH (7TH) DAY OF EACH MONTH FOR THE PRECEDING MONTH IN THE FOLLOWING FORMAT: (1) ANTHRAX. REPORT ACTIVE AND RESERVE FORCE MEMBERS, WHO HAVE BEEN INNOCULATED, SEPARATELY: (A) TOTAL NUMBER REQUIRING VACCINATION: THIS NUMBER SHOULD BE A ROLL UP OF ALL ASSIGNED PERSONNEL WHO WERE PREVIOUSLY REQUIRED TO BE VACCINATED OR WHO ARE PREPARING TO DEPLOY OR HAVE EVER DEPLOYED TO HIGH THREAT AREAS (HTAS) AFTER 15 SEPT 02 AND WHO ARE/WERE REQUIRED TO BE VACCINATED. NOTE: TO AVOID DUPLICATIVE REPORTING, PARENT COMMANDS IN THE SE IN CONUS SHOULD NOT REPORT ANTHRAX VACCINATION DATA ON PERSONNEL WHO ARE DEPLOYED TAD TO HTAS OCONUS. (B) NUMBER NOT PROTECTED: (0-2 SHOTS). NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE RECEIVED 0-2 ANTHRAX SHOTS. (C) NUMBER PROTECTED: (3+ SHOTS TO INCLUDE ANNUAL BOOSTERS). NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE RECEIVED 3 OR MORE SHOTS.

(D) NUMBER OF EXEMPTIONS: (MEDICAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE) NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE A VALID MEDICAL OR

ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION TO ANTHRAX VACCINATION.

(E) NUMBER OF PERSONNEL 30 DAYS OVERDUE FOR NEXT SHOT.(F) NUMBER OF REFUSALS: NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE REFUSED THE ANTHRAX VACCINATION. DO NOT INCLUDE A REFUSAL UNDER ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES: ACCEPTS VACCINATION, OR RECEIVES COURT MARTIAL/NJP IN LIEU OF VACCINATION.

(2) SMALLPOX. REPORT ACTIVE AND RESERVE FORCE MEMBERS SEPARATELY.
(A) TOTAL NUMBER REQUIRING VACCINATION: THIS NUMBER SHOULD BE A ROLL UP OF ALL ASSIGNED PERSONNEL WHO WERE PREVIOUSLY REQUIRED TO BE VACCINATED OR ARE PREPARING TO DEPLOY OR HAVE EVER DEPLOYED TO HTAS AFTER 1 SEPT 02 AND WHO ARE/WERE REQUIRED TO BE VACCINATED. NOTE: TO AVOID DUPLICATIVE REPORTING, PARENT COMMANDS IN THE SE IN CONUS SHOULD NOT REPORT SMALLPOX VACCINATION DATA ON PERSONNEL WHO ARE DEPLOYED TAD TO HTAS OCONUS.

(B) NUMBER NOT PROTECTED: NUMBER OF PERSONNEL DEPLOYING TO A HTA WHO HAVE NOT RECEIVED SMALLPOX VACCINATION.

(C) NUMBER PROTECTED: NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE BEEN VACCINATED.(D) NUMBER OF EXEMPTIONS: NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE A VALID MEDICAL OR ADMINISTRATIVE EXEMPTION FOR THE SMALLPOX VACCINATION.

(E) NUMBER OF REFUSALS: NUMBER OF PERSONNEL WHO HAVE REFUSED THE SMALLPOX VACCINE. DO NOT INCLUDE A REFUSAL UNDER ANY ONE OF THE FOLLOWING CIRCUMSTANCES: ACCEPTS VACCINATION, OR RECEIVES COURT MARTIAL/NJP IN LIEU OF VACCINATION.

B. SPECIFIC GUIDANCE REGARDING SUBMISSION REQUIREMENTS FOR SE COMMANDS AND ACTIVITIES: WITH THE FLOW OF MARINES AND SAILORS IN AND OUT OF THE HTAS AND SUBSEQUENT REASSIGNMENT OF SOME TO COMMANDS AND ACTIVITIES WITHIN THE SE, THE AVIP AND SVP REPORTING REQUIREMENTS OF THOSE MARINES HAS PROVED TO BE A CHALLENGE. THOSE MARINES MUST BE TRACKED AND REPORTED AS DETAILED ABOVE.

(1) THE FOLLOWING SE COMMANDS AND ACTIVITIES WILL SUBMIT REPORTS AS FOLLOWS:

(A) COMMARFORBASESPAC AND COMMARFORBASESLANT. SUBMIT CONSOLIDATED INFORMATION AS A STAND ALONE REPORT, EACH USING ITS RESPECTIVE PLAD.
(B) CG MCNCRC. CONSOLIDATE AND SUBMIT REPORTS FOR MCB QUANTICO, AR DIVISION, AND HENDERSON HALL (TO INCLUDE HQMC PERSONNEL UNDER THE COMMAND OF THE CO, HQBN, HQMC AND THE CO, HQSVCBN, MCB QUANTICO).
COORDINATE WITH, AND PROVIDE TO THE CG MCCDC, CG MCRC, DIR MCOTEA, CG MARCORSYSCOM, CO MCIA, AND DIR JNLW, ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX VACCINATION DATA ON THEIR PERSONNEL UNDER THE COMMAND OF THE CO, HQSVCBN, MCB QUANTICO.

(C) CG MCCDC. CONSOLIDATE AND SUBMIT REPORTS FOR ALL PERSONNEL ASSIGNED TO THE MCCDC HQ AND SUBORDINATE ORGANIZATIONS EXCEPT MCB QUANTICO. COORDINATE WITH CG MCNCRC FOR OBTAINING ANTHRAX AND SMALLPOX VACCINATION DATA ON MCCDC HQ, EFDC, MCWL, AND TECOM PERSONNEL UNDER THE COMMAND OF THE CO, HQSVCBN, MCB QUANTICO.

(D) MARCORSYSCOM. CONSOLIDATE REPORTS FOR HEADQUARTERS PERSONNEL ABOARD QUANTICO AND SUBORDINATE COMMANDS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.
(E) MCRC. CONSOLIDATE REPORTS FOR HEADQUARTERS PERSONNEL ABOARD QUANTICO AND SUBORDINATE COMMANDS, TO INCLUDE DISTRICTS AND RECRUITING STATIONS, THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

(F) MCOTEA. CONSOLIDATE REPORTS FOR HEADQUARTERS PERSONNEL ABOARD QUANTICO AND SUBORDINATE COMMANDS THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.(G) MCIA. CONSOLIDATE REPORTS FOR HEADQUARTERS PERSONNEL AND SUBORDINATE ORGANIZATIONS ABOARD QUANTICO AND THROUGHOUT THE COUNTRY.

(H) THE FOLLOWING UNITS WILL SUBMIT THEIR REPORTS DIRECTLY TO HQMC: (1) HMX-1 (2) MARINE BARRACKS, WASHINGTON, DC (3) JOINT NONLETHAL WEAPONS DIRECTORATE 4. ADMINISTRATION AND LOGISTICS A. TRANSMISSION OF IMMUNIZATIONS DATA. REF E PROVIDES DETAILED INFORMATION ON THE PROCESS TO ENSURE THAT IMMUNIZATIONS ARE TRACKED AND RECORDED INTO THE SHIPBOARD NON-TACTICAL AUTOMATED PROCESSING (SNAP) AUTOMATED MEDICAL SYSTEM (SAMS), VIA NAVY MEDICINE ONLINE (NMO) THROUGH THE NAVAL MEDICAL INFORMATION MANAGEMENT CENTER (NMIMC) FOR FINAL SUBMISSION INTO THE DEFENSE ENROLLMENT ELIGIBILITY REPORTING SYSTEM (DEERS). ACTIVITIES ADMINISTERING IMMUNIZATIONS MUST VERIFY THAT INFORMATION ENTERED INTO SAMS IS REFLECTED IN DEERS. THE COMMAND ADMINISTERING VACCINATION IS RESPONSIBLE TO DOCUMENT AND ENTER INTO SAMS FOR ALL DOD MEMBERS REGARDLESS OF HOME COMMAND.
