SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade Policy Memorandum #13, Suspension of Installation Driving Privileges for Excessive Speed



2. Purpose: I am committed to providing a safe and secure environment to all individuals granted access to Fort George G. Meade. Recently, I have seen an alarming number of traffic cases involving individuals driving excess of 20 miles per hour over the posted speed limit. I am deeply concerned about this, as it directly impacts the safety of our personnel, Families, and visitors. The purpose of this policy is to provide guidance on my standards for suspension.

3. Applicability: This policy is applicable to all individuals granted access to Fort George G. Meade, Maryland.

4. Policy: Drivers cited or ticketed for speeding more than 20 miles per hour over the posted speed limit may have their installation driving privileges suspended for a 30 day period. I intend to carefully review each of these cases and I will administratively suspend on post driving privileges when I determine that cause or a lawful reason exists. Restoration of driving privileges may occur on a case-by-case basis and will be in accordance with policies stated in AR 190-5, para 2-4.
