MEMORANDUM FOR SEE DISTRIBUTION

SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade Policy Memorandum # 37, Reservations of Authority over Commissioned Officers, Warrant Officers, and any Soldier in the Grade of E-8 and Above

1. The authority to impose administrative action, and nonjudicial and judicial punishment under the Uniform Code of Military Justice over all commissioned officers, warrant officers, and any Soldier in the grade of E-8 or above assigned or attached for military justice purposes to Fort George G. Meade or to the United States Army Garrison, Fort George G. Meade is reserved by the Commander, Military District of Washington.
2. When a commissioned officer, warrant officer, or any Soldier in the grade of E-8 and above commits an offense that warrants administrative action, and/or nonjudicial or judicial punishment, his or her commander will, within 24 hours of becoming aware of the misconduct, notify the Commander, Fort George G. Meade, ATTN: IMME-JA, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland 20755-5030, through the Office of the Staff Judge Advocate, ATTN: CPT Lance E. Clark, Chief, Military Justice at (301) 677-9781.
3. When a commissioned officer, warrant officer, or any Soldier in the grade of E-8 and above commits an offense that warrants administrative action, and/or nonjudicial or judicial punishment, his or her commander will forward a request for imposition of nonjudicial or judicial punishment, accompanied by an explanation of the circumstances or a report of any investigation conducted by the command or law enforcement authorities, memorandum thru Commander, Fort George G. Meade, ATTN: IMME-JA, Fort George G. Meade, Maryland 20755-5030, for the Commander, Military District of Washington, ATTN: ANJA-CL, 103 Third Avenue, SW, Fort Lesley J. McNair, DC 20319.
