SUBJECT: Fort George G. Meade Policy Memorandum #80, Constitution Park
Fountain Rules

1. The purpose of this memorandum is to establish the rules and hours of operation for the fountain located in Constitution Park.

2. The fountain will be operational from 1 April – 1 November every year.

Opening day for the fountain can be adjusted due to an unseasonably long winter and can be postponed until such a time it is feasible to open the fountain.

Closing day for the fountain can be adjusted due to an abnormal amount of foliage complicating maintenance on the fountain.

3. The fountain will be turned on at 0600 each morning and turned off at 2300 each evening.

4. The following are rules for proper conduct in/around the fountain

- a. Swimming in the fountain is prohibited.
- b. Wading in the fountain is prohibited.
- c. Throwing foreign objects such as coins into the fountain is prohibited.
- d. Playing in the fountain with items such as remote controlled boats is prohibited.
- e. Standing on the ledge surrounding the fountain is prohibited.
- f. Sitting on the edge of the fountain and immersing hands or feet into the water is prohibited.
- g. Pets will not be allowed in the fountain.
- h. Climbing on the fountain is prohibited.
