

# **Music Education: Grade 3**

### **Musical Performance**

- Sings blending vocal timbres, matching dynamic levels and responds to simple conducting cues
- Performs simple ostinati and rounds
- Performs appropriate independent parts while other students sing or play same or contrasting parts
- Reads symbols and traditional terms referring to dynamics, tempo, and pitch
- Notates symbols and traditional terms referring to dynamics, tempo, and pitch
- Listens to examples of simple musical form such as verse-refrain and call-and-response
- Responds to various examples of musical forms
- Describes examples of form in music

## **History and Culture**

- Describes roles of musicians in various settings and cultures
- Identifies cultural contributions to music appropriate to developmental level
- Performs appropriate music related to history and culture

#### **Assessment of Music**

- Describes performances using standard musical vocabulary
- Compares performances from two or more sources using standard musical vocabulary

#### **Connections to Other Disciplines**

- Relates what is learned in music with other curricular areas
- Names and discusses music career opportunities

#### **Technology Integration**

Acquires developmentally appropriate technology skills and vocabulary
