Musical Performance

- Plays appropriate music as defined by range, tone quality, accidentals, technique, phrasing, rhythmic accuracy, dynamics, and tempo
- Performs with simple musical expression and interpretation
- Reads sixteenth notes and triplets
- Notates sixteenth notes and triplets
- Correctly places pitches and rhythms in treble clef
- Reads symbols of simple musical expression
- Listens to and describes musical styles in an aural example

History and Culture

- Compares different examples of world music
- Compares purposes of various types of world music
- Performs appropriate music related to history and culture

Assessment of Music

- Compares various types of music including different interpretations of identical works
- Uses appropriate terminology to explain similarities and differences of various types of music including interpretations of identical works

Connections to Other Disciplines

 Integrates what is learned about various types of music with other curricular areas
