

Major Changes from Previous TCCC Curriculum of 01 November 2010

- Added a recommendation to use junctional tourniquets like the CRoC™ for hemorrhage control in lower extremity wounds not amenable to traditional limb tourniquets in Tactical Field Care and Tactical Evacuation Care.
- Added a recommendation in Tactical Field Care and Tactical Evacuation Care to use Tranexamic Acid (TXA) in casualties who are anticipated to need significant blood product transfusion.
- Added new recommendation for bilateral needle thoracotomy in casualties who lose vital signs prior to terminating resuscitation efforts in Tactical Field Care and Tactical Evacuation Care.
- Added recommendation to consider CPR under specified circumstances in Tactical Evacuation Care when it does not deny lifesaving care to other casualties or hinder the mission.
