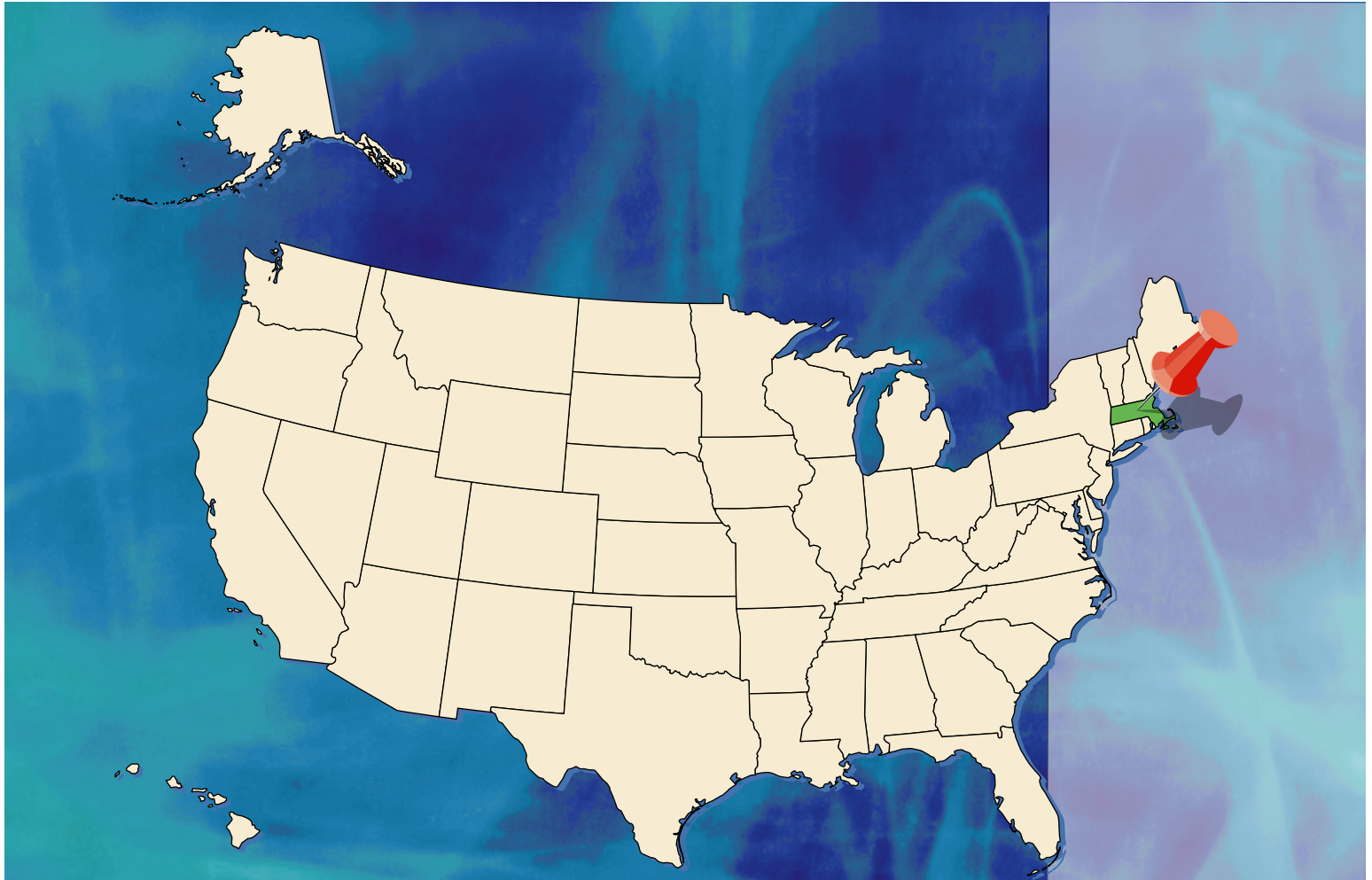

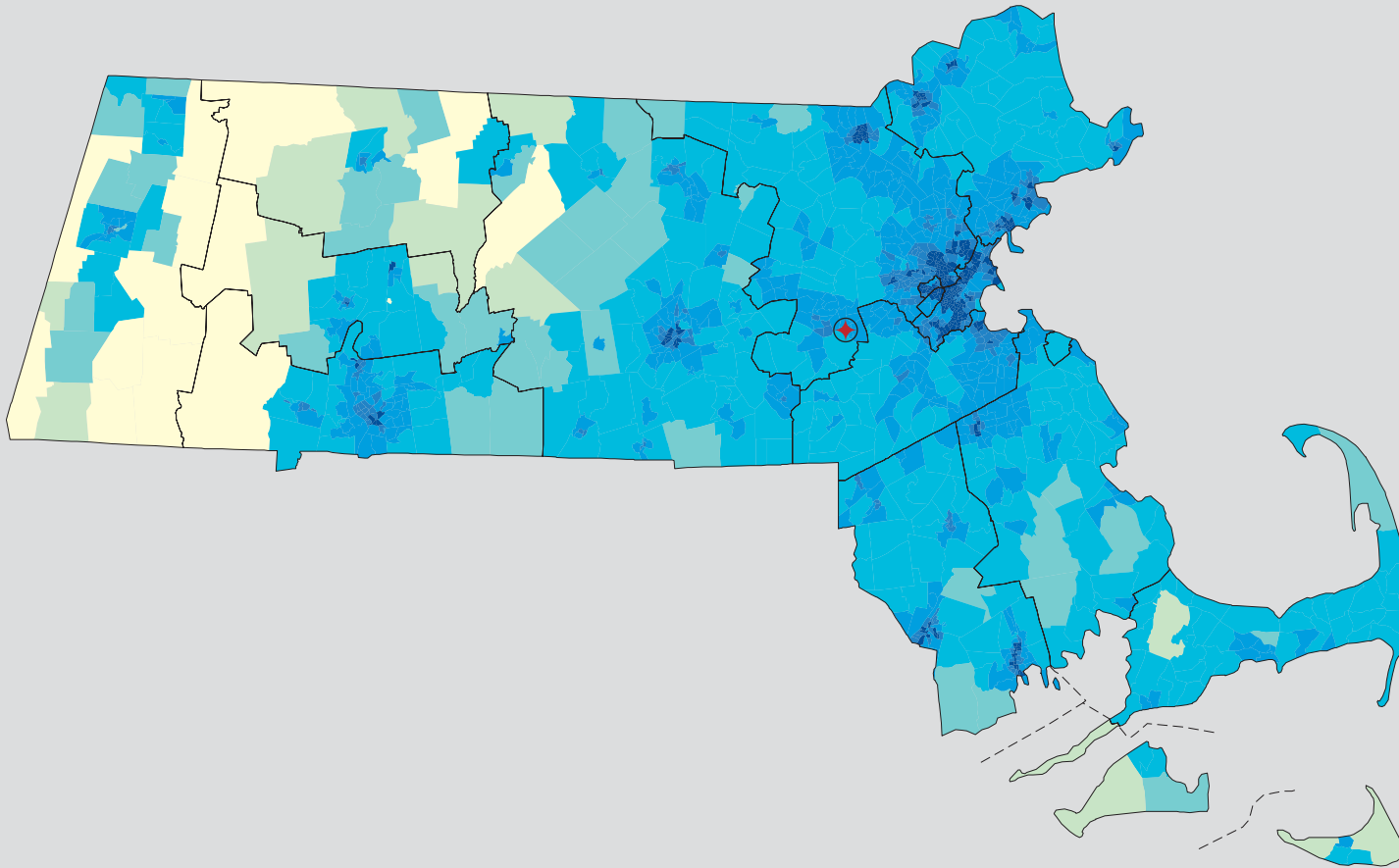

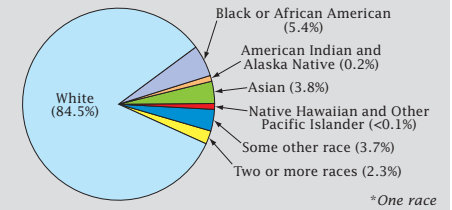

## Population Density by Census Tract

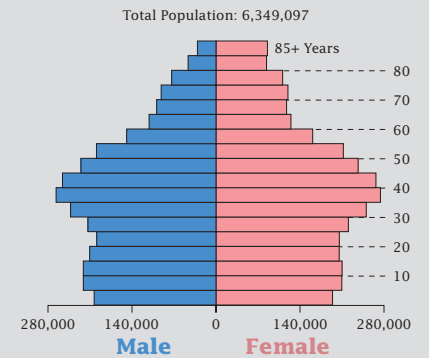


## State Race\* Breakdown

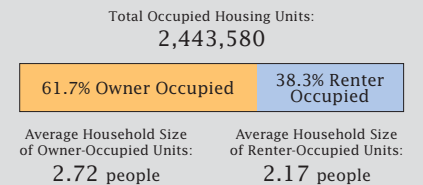


Hispanic or Latino (of any race) makes up **6.8%** of the state population.

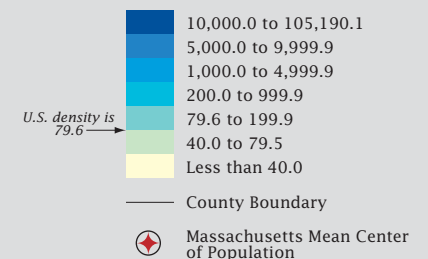
## Population by Sex and Age
