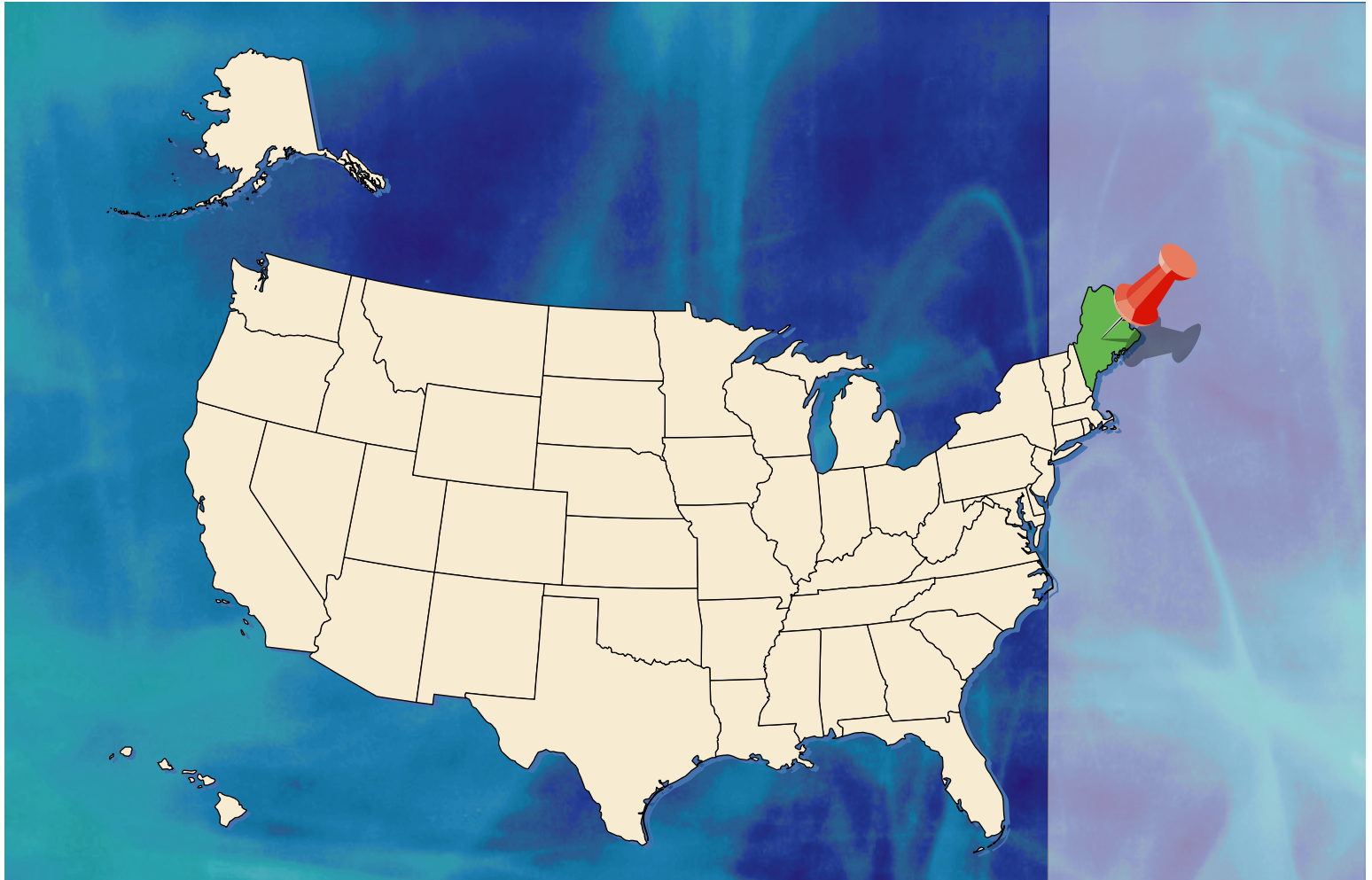

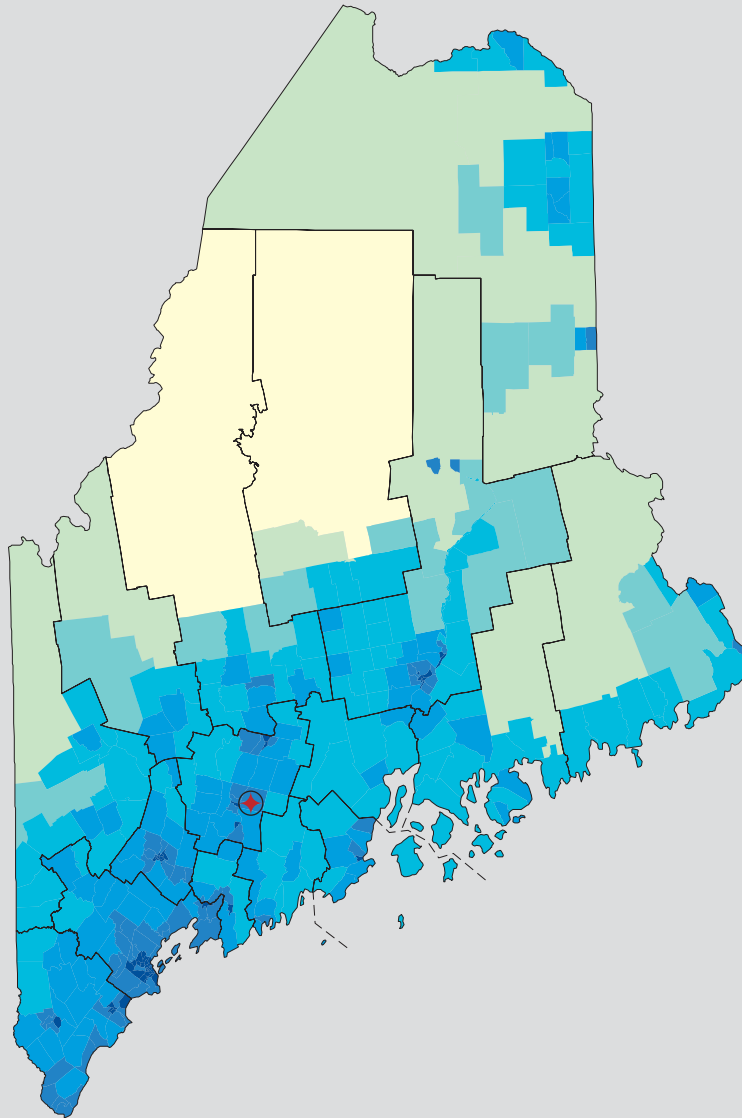

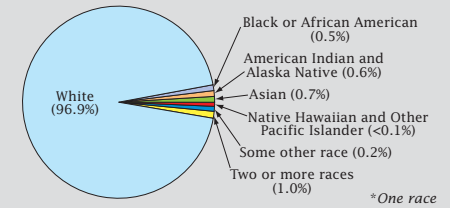

## Population Density by Census Tract

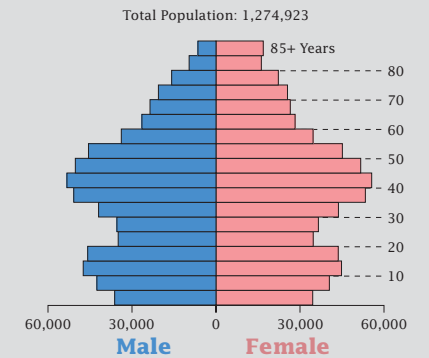


## State Race\* Breakdown

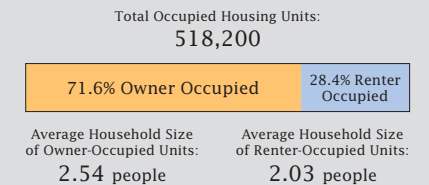

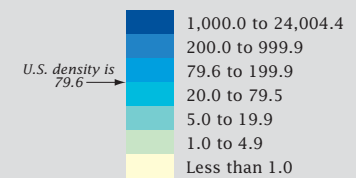
## Population by Sex and Age



## Housing Tenure

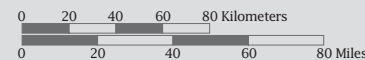


## Population Per Square Mile by Census Tract
