2010 Medication Copayment Rate





VA charges a copay for each 30-day or less supply of medication provided on an outpatient basis for the treatmentof a non-service connected condition.

Effective July 1, 2010, the copay amounts are:

| Priority Groups | Copay Amount | | |
|------------------------|-----------------|------------------|------------------|
| | 1–30 day supply | 31–60-day supply | 61–90-day supply |
| 2 through 6 | \$8 | \$16 | \$24 |
| 7 and 8 | \$9 | \$18 | \$27 |

Copayments stop each calendar year for priority groups 2-6 once a \$960 cap is reached.

These changes apply to:

- Veterans without a service connected condition, or
- Veterans with a disability rated less than 50%
 - who are receiving outpatient treatment for a non service-connected condition, and
 - whose annual income exceeds the limit set by law.

Note: Medication Copayments do not apply to former Prisoners of War or those covered by other exceptions as set by law.
