Reminder: All Site Call Wednesday, July 18th - Noon ET

The agenda for the next couple of calls will focus on reflection about the foundational strategies that have been put in place in Year 1 and the structure that site champions envision in moving forward. It is encouraged that sites think about strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and threats and how these components might contribute to structural changes, engagement or practice. Sites might share these changes and how they anticipate the changes to impact the system. Each site will be asked to present one time. For each presentation, one site will be asked to serve as discussant. Every site should have an opportunity to participate. **Boise** has agreed to start us off and has provided some documentation for review on the Coordinating Center Sharepoint in the **Boise folder**. Laurie Traylor will solicit two other sites to participate in this Wednesday's call.

Points for discussion might include:

- What are content from year 1 that you are keeping and why
- What content are you making dramatic changes in and why
- Discuss both content and structure (timing, level of trainee engagement, teaching methodology...)changes you are making
- Using the triangle from the Annual Meeting
 - Are you changing/adding reflection and with what content
 - o Are you changing/adding experiential/workplace learning and with what content
 - o Are you changing/adding didactic/classroom learning and with what content
