Tools and Training You Can Use

Today's PACT Community of Practice Meeting focused on the integration of Home Telehealth (CCHT) into the PACT Team model. Highlights of the presentation introduced ways in which CCHT helps to support the PACT Team. CCHT staff can help eliminate some of the burden on the team by supporting:

- Patients who call frequently and have multiple needs
- ▶ Patients who have frequent needs related to medication monitoring and changes and communication with Pharmacy
- Patients that need home support with BP checks- (decreasing office visits)
- ▶ Patients that require Blood Glucose level monitoring (collaboration with diabetic clinic)
- ▶ Patients with frequent weight changes- Cardiology
- Medication optimization
- ▶ Collaboration with Pain Management Clinic
- ▶ Collaboration with Hospice/Palliative Care Teams
- Liaison with various specialty care services
- Providing support for family caregivers.
