MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs, Veterans Health Administration (VHA) and the American Federation of Government Employees, AFL-CIO, National Veterans Affairs Council #53 (NVAC) regarding VHA Directive 2003-047 dated August 14, 2003 entitled "Transitional Pharmacy Benefit."

- 1. The national parties agree that bargaining unit employees will not be held responsible for using a non-VA physician on DHHS Exclusion List prior to that non-VA physician being added to the list.
- 2. The Department will provide bargaining unit employees with the necessary training to perform their required duties in accordance with Article 34, Section 4 of the VA/AFGE Master Agreement dated March 21, 1997.
- 3. The parties agree that any changes to bargaining unit employee(s) performance standards will be in accordance with Article 26, Section 2 of the VA/AF 3E Master Agreement.
- 4. Management shall provide the Chair of the NVAC Mid-Term Bargaining Committee with an electronic copy and all studies to determine the effect of this program on the productivity of all affected bargaining unit employees.
- 5. Local parties may negotiate further on this subject so long as they do not conflict, change, interfere with or impair the implementation of this MOU and VA/AFGE Master Agreement.
- 6. The appropriate management official shall provide a copy of this MOU to the National and Local union officials at their facility upon receipt of this MOU.
