Memorandum of Understanding

VA Handbook 5011, Part II, Chapter 4, Alternative Workplace **Arrangements (Telework)**

The following constitutes an agreement between the Department of Veterans Affairs (Agency) and the National Association of Government Employees (NAGE) concerning the DVA Telework process.

- 1. The Agency and NAGE National agree that if the Agency is required by a change in law or regulation to revise its Telework policy in a way that conflicts with the terms of Article 14, the national parties will bargain over the revision in accordance with Article 10, Part B, Section 2.
- 2. Management will consider the use of telework for employees receiving OWCP benefits when appropriate and feasible in accordance with Article 49, Section 5 of the Master Agreement.
- 3. Upon request, management and the local union can bargain general overtime procedures in accordance with Article 12, Section 4 of the Master Agreement or Local Agreements.
- 4. Within the five (5) calendar days of receipt, the appropriate management official at each facility shall provide a copy of this MOU to the Local union President.
