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






#### Increasing Number of Women Veterans


Since 2000, the number of women Veterans seeking VA health care services has more than doubled.

# VA Maternity and Newborn Benefits

- Maternity Care
  - Part of benefits package for women Veterans since 1996
- Newborn Care
  - The Caregivers and Veteran Omnibus Health Service Act - May 5, 2010, Section 206
  - Post delivery newborn care for first seven days of life to newborns delivered by women Veterans who receive maternity care benefits through VA







#### Transforming Reproductive Healthcare:

### Ensuring Safe, Quality Maternity Care

- Growing need for maternity care with growth of women Veterans younger than 45 years of age (childbearing age)
- Most maternity care is provided by non-VA providers in non-VA facilities
- During pregnancy, women Veterans may require care at the VA for non-pregnancy related health conditions (e.g. depression, chronic pain, etc.)
- Care coordination is critical for ensuring quality care
- Tracking all maternity and newborn care outcomes is essential for a high performing system






### Our Goal

- Seamless, effective coordination across settings to ensure high quality maternity care
  - Develop VA-wide tool to allow real-time coordination and tracking of maternity care during pregnancy
  - Develop a searchable database of maternity and newborn care outcomes
- Coordinate care to best meet the needs of Veteran mothers and their newborns through
  - Communication
  - Coordinated care management plans
  - Coordinated provider responsibilities





#### Multiple Transitions of Care for Pregnant Women Veterans









# **Maternity Care Tracking Tool**

 Innovative Tool to Track Maternity Outcomes & Facilitate Care Coordination in Pregnant Women Veterans













#### Veteran

- Seamless coordination, communication (i.e. order prescriptions, VA appointments)
- Postpartum reintegration into VA
- Consideration of health history, values and wishes, plan of care, medications, and evolving needs are communicated seamlessly across systems





Coordinator

- Seamless VA and non-VA coordination
- Automated reminders to call Veteran every trimester
- Facilitate postpartum reintegration back into VA
- Real time access to maternity records
- Searchable database for tracking active maternity patients





#### Provider

- VA Provider has real-time access to maternity information
- Non-VA Provider seamlessly communicates with VA providers
- Coordinated care management plans/ tools





**VA System** 


- Veteran registered automatically in tracker and coordinator notified
- Quality outcomes reported and tracked
- Information is shared through electronic health records and other interoperable data systems
- Maternity Care/Newborn Care searchable within VSSC



- 1330.03 (In concurrence): Maternity Health Care and Coordination Handbook will establish procedures for providing and coordinating maternity care for pregnant women Veterans enrolled in the VA health care system.

- Seamless transitions of care
  - From pregnancy to childbirth to postpartum care
  - Between VA and non-VA settings
  - Between VA and non-VA providers of care
- Seamless exchange of information between the Veteran, non-VA maternity provider, VA- provider and VA- coordinator during pregnancy
  - Real-time tracking of maternity and newborn care outcomes
