EXPLANATORY MANUAL TO THE CONVENTION ON FACILITATION OF INTERNATIONAL MARITIME TRAFFIC, 1965, AS AMENDED

Corrigendum

Replace the existing text of the paragraph commencing "According to the 1951 UN Convention and the 1967 ..." (4.1) in the annex to FAL.3/Circ.202, with the following text:

"According to the 1951 UN Convention and the 1967 UN Protocol on the Status of Refugees, a contracting State shall not expel or return ('refouler') a refugee in any manner whatsoever to the frontiers of territories where his life or freedom is being threatened on account of his race, religion, nationality, membership of a particular social group or political opinion (article 33.1). The principle of non-refoulement does not only forbid the expulsion of refugees to their country of origin but to any country in which they might be subject to persecution."
