Additional Items to Consider Adding to an Emergency Supply Kit:

- Prescription medications and glasses
- Infant formula and diapers
- **Pet food and extra water for your pet**
- Important family documents such as copies of insurance policies, identification and bank account records in a waterproof, portable container
- Cash or traveler's checks and change
- Emergency reference material such as a first aid book or information from www.ready.gov
- □ Sleeping bag or warm blanket for each person. Consider additional bedding if you live in a cold-weather climate.
- Complete change of clothing including a long sleeved shirt, long pants and sturdy shoes. Consider additional clothing if you live in a cold-weather climate.
- Household chlorine bleach and medicine dropper When diluted nine parts water to one part bleach, bleach can be used as a disinfectant. Or in an emergency, you can use it to treat water by using 16 drops of regular household liquid bleach per gallon of water. Do not use scented, color safe or bleaches with added cleaners.
- **Fire Extinguisher**
- Matches in a waterproof container
- Feminine supplies and personal hygiene items
- Mess kits, paper cups, plates and plastic utensils, paper towels
- Paper and pencil
- Books, games, puzzles or other activities for children

Recommended Items to Include in a Basic Emergency Supply Kit:

Water, one gallon of water per person per day for at least three days, for drinking and sanitation

Foo

Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food

Battery-powered or hand crank radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert and extra batteries for both

Flashlight and extra batteries

First aid kit

Whistle to signal for help

Dust mask, to help filter contaminated air and plastic sheeting and duct tape to shelter-in-place

Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation

Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities

Can opener for food (if kit contains canned food)

Local maps

Through its Ready Campaign, the Federal Emergency Management Agency educates and empowers Americans to take some simple steps to prepare for and respond to potential emergencies, including natural disasters and terrorist attacks. *Ready* asks individuals to do three key things: get an emergency supply kit, make a family emergency plan, and be informed about the different types of emergencies that could occur and their appropriate responses.

All Americans should have some basic supplies on hand in order to survive for at least three days if an emergency occurs. Following is a listing of some basic items that every emergency supply kit should include. However, it is important that individuals review this list and consider where they live and the unique needs of their family in order to create an emergency supply kit that will meet these needs. Individuals should also consider having at least two emergency supply kits, one full kit at home and smaller portable kits in their workplace, vehicle or other places they spend time.

The course spanned from Western Albemarle County through wine and horse country to the North and East of Richmond and finally joined with the Capital Trail to finish at the Jamestown Beach Park in Williamsburg Virginia.

The team completed the 206 mile journey in 29 hours and 23 minutes, and averaged an 8:23 min/mile pace.







Walt Disney World Armed Forces Salute Promotion 2012-2013

Request and Prepay through Coast Guard Training Center Yorktown (TCY) – MWR Allow up to 14 days for Tickets

Walt Disney World Armed Forces Salute Program, 2012-2013. This promotion will run during the period of 1 October 2012 thru 28 September 2013. This promotion entitles "Eligible Service Members" to receive, up to a maximum of 6 promotional products.

"Eligible Service Members" defined: Active or Retired members of the U.S. Military, including activated members of the National Guard and Reservists as well as active and retired members of the United States Cost Guard. ONLY!

During the offer period, **4-Day Disney's Armed Forces Salute tickets** with or without options may be purchased only by "Eligible Service Members" (or their spouse, but not both), for their family and friends. **4-Day Disney's Armed Forces Salute tickets** are limited to (6) per (check special provisions sheet for clarification) "Eligible Service Members".

Walt Disney World Special Provisions

- During the period from August 17, 2012 to September 25, 2013 (the "Offer Period"), Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets may be purchased at participating U.S. military sales outlets ONLY by Eligible Service Members (defined below) or their spouses (but not both), for themselves and other family members and friends, in accordance with these "Special Provisions." These Tickets may not be otherwise transferred, distributed or resold.
- "Eligible Service Members" are active or retired members of the U.S. military, including active members of the National Guard or Reservists and active or retired members of the U.S. Coast Guard.
- Participating military sales outlets must require that Eligible Service Members (or their spouses) present valid military identification to purchase Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets.
- Eligible Service Members (or their spouses) who purchase Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets for themselves and their family members and friends will be required to activate those Tickets at *Walt Disney World*® theme park ticket windows, no later than September 25, 2013, in order for those Tickets to be used. Valid military identification will be required.
- No more than six (6) Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets may be purchased and activated by any Eligible Service Member and/or spouse (regardless of the place of purchase and whether purchased by that person or that person's spouse), and all six (6) must be purchased at the same time. In addition, a valid military ID may be required for admission.
- Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets (including any options) expire and may not be used after September 28, 2013. In addition, these Tickets (including any options) may not be used on the following blackout dates: December 24, 2012 to December 31, 2012 and March 24, 2013 to April 4, 2013 at all *Walt Disney World®* Theme Parks and other gated attractions; and July 4, 2013 at *Magic Kingdom®* Park only.
- The above limitations must be disclosed to each Eligible Service Member (or spouse) before that Eligible Service Member (or spouse) is permitted to purchase any Disney's 4-Day Military Promotional Tickets.
