The Copyright Alliance has informed me of this welcome invitation from the Obama Administration to share my thoughts on my rights as a creator.

I write novels, and I care deeply about copyright infringement of the works I create. Imagine having a friend tell you they read your novel **before it came out ... before you'd even seen it in print .**... by buying an illegally obtained "copy" on eBay. Imagine speaking at a book club meeting and offering to autograph everyone's book, only to notice that one of the books has a cover that's a slightly different design, and a different typeface inside. When you ask the person where they bought it, they turn red, and say they don't remember.

Fellow writers try to educate people that these acts and others are taking money away from writers, not corporations . . . but in the era of "free", our voices don't seem to be enough. It would be great to see a public service campaign about intellectual property theft, and how it affects so many artists.
