



The “Avenue of Flags” and special banners are put up on the following occasions/holidays. Listed next to the occasion/holiday is either **CODE F**, indicating the **entire** “Avenue of Flags” will be flown, or **Code A**, indicating the **abbreviated** (one-third of the full complement) be flown. The large American flag will be flown only with the full “Avenue of Flags” or upon special request. For holidays occurring during wintry months, please watch the weather forecast and plan raising the flags accordingly. The “Avenue of Flags” may be put up on the Friday preceding a Monday holiday or the day prior to the occasion.
