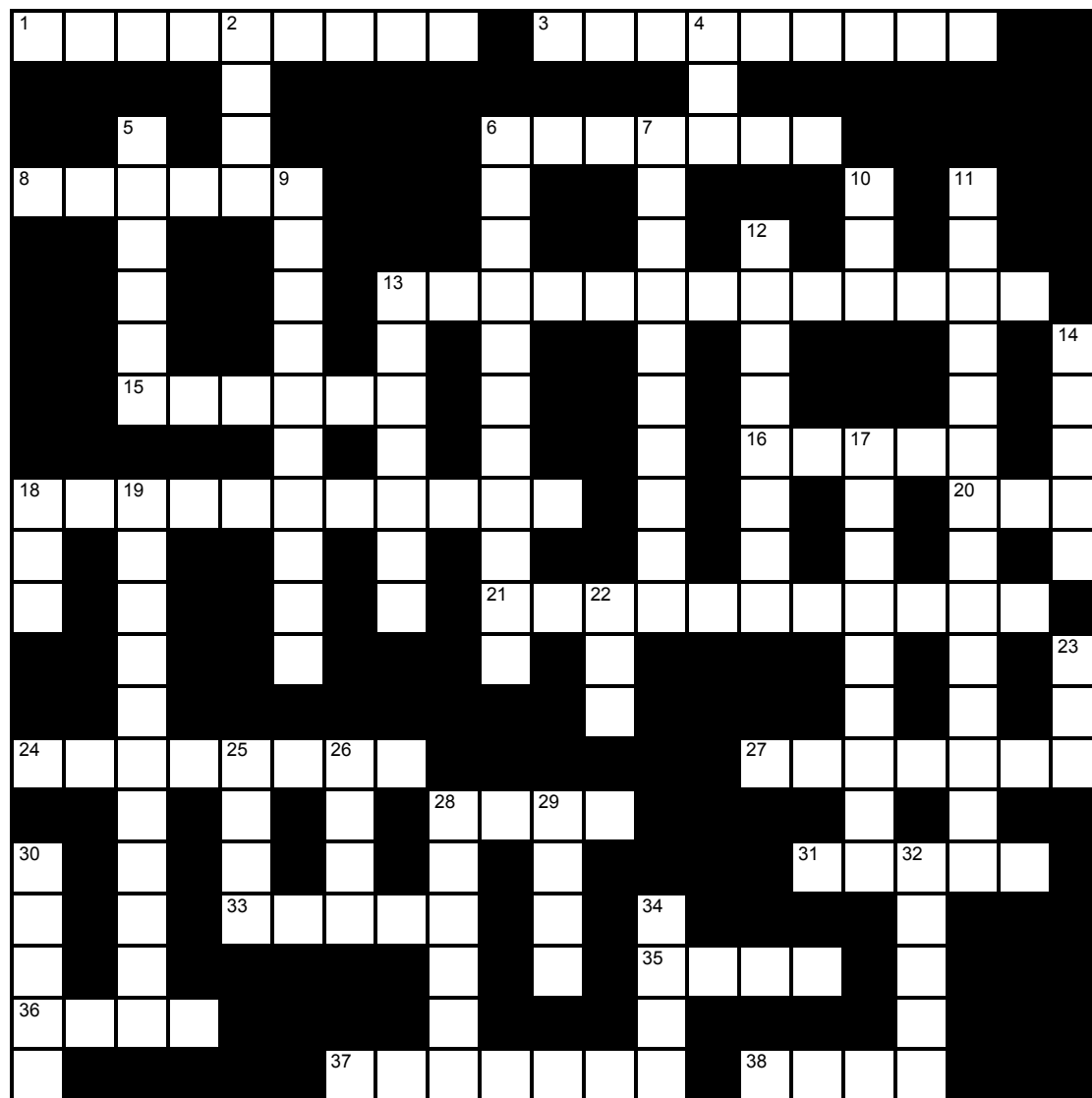

- 1 Antigen testing used to check immunity (9)
- 3 Earliest age influenza vaccine can be administered (9)
- 6 Hypersensitivity (7)
- 8 Per OSHA not needed when administering injectable vaccines (6)

## Down

- 2 Vaccine type contraindicated for pregnant women (4)
- 4 Only vaccine currently FDA approved for jet injection (3)
- 5 Vaccine indicated for individuals 60 years and older (6)

- 13 Preferred injection site for children aged 3–18 years (13)
- 15 Vaccine indicated for individuals who work with animal population (6)
- 16 Federal program for compensating victims of vaccine-related injuries; abbr. (5)
- 18 Vaccines that can be given at any interval (11)
- 20 Organization to report vaccine preventable disease infections; abbr. (3)
- 21 Live vaccines can be administered same day or separated by how long, days (11)
- 24 Common injection site reaction (8)
- 27 Lethargy after vaccination (7)
- 28 Indicated for new parents to prevent spread of whooping cough (4)
- 31 This sap from rubber trees may cause allergic reaction (5)
- 33 Number of antigens in DTaP (5)
- 35 Route of administration for rotavirus vaccine (4)
- 36 Basis for age-specific vaccine recommendations (4)
- 37 Storage location for varicella vaccine (7)
- 38 Type of immunity conferred by well vaccinated population (4)
- 6 Age group most difficult to capture for routine immunizations (11)
- 7 Vaccine inventory should be rotated to prevent (10)
- 9 Vaccine component that may cause allergic reaction, i.e. MSG (10)
- 10 CDC info sheet before vaccination (3)
- 11 Conjugation with a protein improves effectiveness of which vaccine type (14)
- 12 Protection from disease (8)
- 13 Rule for vaccine syringes filled by staff not used by end of clinic day (7)
- 14 Minimum requirement for storage unit daily temperature checks (5)
- 17 Indicated for children 12 mos and older to prevent contagious pustule rash (9)
- 18 Service member immunization documentation system; abbr. (3)
- 19 May begin within minutes of vaccine administration (11)
- 22 Anaphylaxis antidote; abbr. (3)
- 23 Needle length used for a 60-70 kg women, inches (3)
- 25 Vaccine storage enemy (4)
- 26 Publication for ACIP vaccine recommendations; abbr. (4)
- 28 Minimum age for first dose of MMR, months (6)
- 29 Advisory body that recommends immunization requirements (4)
- 30 Vaccine Adverse Event Reporting System; abbr. (5)
- 32 Trimester of pregnancy that Tdap is recommended (5)
- 34 Consider vaccination valid if administered before minimum interval, days (4)
