

"Here's to the Heroes" Program Provides Free Admission for Military Members and Direct Dependents To Theme Parks Operated by SeaWorld Parks &

As part of the Here's to the Heroes program, free admission is provided to SeaWorld and Busch Gardens for members of U.S. and coalition armed forces and their families through 2012.

The program provides a single day's free admission to any one SeaWorld or Busch Gardens park, Sesame Place, Adventure Island or Water Country USA for the service member and as many as three of his or her direct dependents.

Any active duty, active reserve, ready reserve service member or National Guardsman representing any of the five service branches is entitled to free admission under the program. He or she need only register either online at www.herosalute.com or in the entrance plaza of a participating park, and show a Department of Defense photo ID in addition all dependents over the age of 10 must present a valid Dependent ID for entry into the park. The offer also applies to members of foreign military forces serving in the coalitions in Iraq or Afghanistan or attached to American units in the U.S. for training.

Inactive, standby and retired reserve members, military retirees, U.S. Merchant Marine and civilian Department of Defense workers are ineligible for the program. The program does not include Discovery Cove or SeaWorld's waterpark, Aquatica.


We will be accepting applications for February reservations at the Nantucket Recreation House November 1st-7th. Reservations for February are for 2 - 7 days.

GEAR ISSUE

- NOTICE: Bounce Houses will stop being issued for the season Tuesday November 6th. Unless an indoor venue is provided, bounce houses will not be available to reserve until February 1, 2013 at the earliest.
- Now Authorized MWR patrons (including Dependents 18 years or older) may checkout gear for a flat \$5.00 administrative fee (no matter how much gear is needed).
- Additional fees will be accessed for items such as fuel tanks and gas if MWR provides fuel originally.
- Items will be issued out on Fridays and returned on Tuesdays
