Page ³~~4~~, at line ¹⁹~~4~~ strike the second close quotation marks and the second period, and after line ¹⁹~~4~~ insert the following:

1 “(7)(A) Notwithstanding any other provision of this
2 section, the Secretary shall not make available for leasing
3 under an oil and gas leasing program under this section
4 any area of the outer Continental Shelf within the offshore
5 administrative boundaries of the State of New Jersey, if
6 the Governor of New Jersey certifies to the Secretary that
7 the voters of that State disapproved lease sales for the
8 period of that program for that area in a referendum con-
9 ducted in accordance with the laws of the State.

10 “(B) A certification of a Governor and a referendum
11 referred to clause (i) and shall apply for purposes of this
12 subparagraph only with respect to one 5-year oil and gas
13 leasing program under this section.

14 “(C) In this subparagraph the term ‘offshore admin-
15 istrative boundaries’ means the boundaries depicted with
16 respect to New Jersey on the Bureau of Ocean Energy,
17 Management, and Enforcement map entitled ‘Atlantic
